LARGE PROBLEMS CAN BE INTIMIDATING. TRY BREAKING THEM DOWN INTO MANAGEABLE CHUNKS. FOR EXAMPLE, IF A PROBLEM INVOLVES MULTIPLE STEPS OR CONCEPTS, TACKLE EACH PIECE ONE AT A TIME RATHER THAN TRYING TO SOLVE EVERYTHING SIMULTANEOUSLY.

3. CHOOSE AN APPROPRIATE METHOD OR FORMULA
