The book's title is inspired in part by James Baldwin, who testified in Congress in 1968 that My history... contains the truth about America. It is going to be hard to teach it. *Long Road to Hard Truth* concludes that this journey took 100 years because many in America are unwilling to confront the history of America's legacy of slavery and discrimination, and that the only reason this museum finally became a reality is that an unlikely, bipartisan coalition of political leaders had the courage and wisdom to declare that America could not, and should not, continue to evade the hard truth.
