ADDITIONALLY, VARYING SENTENCE LENGTH AND COMPLEXITY CAN HELP WRITERS GRADUALLY BUILD CONFIDENCE. STARTING WITH SIMPLE, SHORT PHRASES AND PROGRESSING TO LONGER, MORE COMPLEX SENTENCES CHALLENGES THE HAND AND MIND IN BALANCED INCREMENTS.

FOCUS ON LETTER COMBINATIONS AND PUNCTUATION

EFFECTIVE HANDWRITING PRACTICE SENTENCES TARGET TROUBLESOME LETTER PAIRS OR FREQUENTLY USED PUNCTUATION MARKS.
