FOR INSTANCE, THE EXPLORATION OF MEMORY AND THE FLUIDITY OF TIME RESONATE WITH MOTIFS FOUND IN *TO THE LIGHTHOUSE*, WHERE THE PAST CONTINUALLY INTERACTS WITH THE PRESENT THROUGH THE CHARACTERS' REFLECTIONS.

STRENGTHS AND LIMITATIONS OF THE HAUNTED HOUSE

LEGACY AND CRITICAL RECEPTION

ALTHOUGH *THE HAUNTED HOUSE* IS NOT AS WIDELY DISCUSSED AS SOME OF WOOLF'S NOVELS, IT HOLDS A SIGNIFICANT PLACE IN MODERNIST LITERATURE AND CONTINUES TO ATTRACT SCHOLARLY ATTENTION. CRITICS OFTEN HIGHLIGHT THE STORY'S INNOVATIVE NARRATIVE FORM AND THEMATIC COMPLEXITY, NOTING HOW IT ANTICIPATES WOOLF'S LATER MASTERPIECES.
