1. BOILING WATER PREPARATION

5. SETTING THE MOLD

REMOVE THE MOUTH GUARD AND PLACE IT IN COLD WATER FOR ABOUT 1 MINUTE. THIS COOLS AND SETS THE MATERIAL IN ITS NEW SHAPE, LOCKING IN THE CUSTOM FIT.

6. TEST THE FIT AND REPEAT IF NEEDED

TRY THE MOUTH GUARD ON AGAIN. IT SHOULD FIT SNUGLY WITHOUT DISCOMFORT OR EXCESSIVE MOVEMENT. IF NECESSARY, REPEAT THE BOILING AND MOLDING PROCESS ONE OR TWO MORE TIMES TO GET THE PERFECT FIT.

MOLDING THE MOUTH GUARD

1. ****FIT IN MOUTH:**** IMMEDIATELY PLACE THE SOFTENED MOUTH GUARD IN YOUR MOUTH, POSITIONING IT OVER YOUR UPPER TEETH.
2. ****BITE DOWN FIRMLY:**** BITE DOWN FIRMLY AND SUCK IN TO CREATE A VACUUM, PRESSING THE GUARD AGAINST YOUR TEETH AND GUMS.
3. ****USE FINGERS TO PRESS:**** USE YOUR FINGERS TO PRESS THE MOUTH GUARD AGAINST THE FRONT TEETH AND CHEEKS, ENSURING THE MATERIAL MOLDS PRECISELY.
4. ****HOLD POSITION:**** MAINTAIN THIS POSITION FOR ABOUT 30 SECONDS TO ALLOW THE MATERIAL TO COOL AND SET.
5. ****CHECK FIT:**** REMOVE THE MOUTH GUARD AND INSPECT THE FIT. IT SHOULD FEEL SNUG BUT COMFORTABLE, WITHOUT EXCESSIVE TIGHTNESS OR LOOSENESS.

ADJUSTMENTS AND REPEAT FITTING

4. **STORING INCORRECTLY:** LEAVING THE GUARD EXPOSED TO HEAT OR CRUSHING FORCES CAN DEFORM IT.
