The public appreciation of the beauty of our exhibitions is yearly growing; and, as the taste for beautiful flowers and fine fruit increases, so will the desire to attend our exhibitions become greater every year, until instead of hundreds there may be, in the near future, thousands to crowd our halls. The amount of money appropriated for prizes, for the year 1884, was \$3,450; this has been increased to \$5,100 for the year 1885.
