UNDERSTANDING ROUGH COUNTRY SUSPENSION LIFT KITS

THIS INCREASE ALLOWS FOR LARGER TIRES, ENHANCED GROUND CLEARANCE, AND BETTER OFF-ROAD CAPABILITY.

STEP-BY-STEP ROUGH COUNTRY INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WHILE THE EXACT STEPS CAN VARY DEPENDING ON YOUR VEHICLE MODEL AND THE SPECIFIC KIT, THE FOLLOWING GENERAL

INSTRUCTIONS OUTLINE THE TYPICAL INSTALLATION PROCESS FOR A ROUGH COUNTRY SUSPENSION LIFT.

1. LIFT AND SECURE THE VEHICLE

START BY LOOSENING THE LUG NUTS ON YOUR WHEELS WITHOUT REMOVING THEM ENTIRELY. USE A FLOOR JACK TO RAISE THE VEHICLE AND PLACE IT SECURELY ON JACK STANDS. REMOVING THE WHEELS WILL GIVE YOU CLEAR ACCESS TO THE SUSPENSION COMPONENTS.

2. REMOVE EXISTING SUSPENSION COMPONENTS

DEPENDING ON YOUR KIT, YOU MAY NEED TO REMOVE SHOCKS, CONTROL ARMS, SWAY BAR LINKS, OR COIL SPRINGS. CAREFULLY FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS TO UNBOLT THESE PARTS, KEEPING TRACK OF HARDWARE FOR REUSE OR REPLACEMENT.

3. INSTALL LIFT COMPONENTS

INSTALL THE PROVIDED SPACERS, NEW SHOCKS, OR CONTROL ARMS AS SPECIFIED. FOR EXAMPLE, COIL SPRING SPACERS ARE TYPICALLY PLACED ON TOP OF THE FACTORY SPRINGS TO RAISE THE VEHICLE'S HEIGHT. MAKE SURE ALL BOLTS ARE TIGHTENED TO THE MANUFACTURER'S RECOMMENDED TORQUE SETTINGS.

4. REASSEMBLE AND DOUBLE-CHECK

REINSTALL ANY COMPONENTS YOU REMOVED EARLIER, SUCH AS SWAY BAR LINKS AND WHEELS. TIGHTEN THE LUG NUTS TO SPECIFICATION AND LOWER THE VEHICLE OFF THE JACK STANDS CAREFULLY.

5. ALIGNMENT AND SAFETY CHECK

AFTER INSTALLATION, IT'S CRUCIAL TO HAVE A PROFESSIONAL WHEEL ALIGNMENT PERFORMED. LIFTING YOUR VEHICLE CHANGES SUSPENSION GEOMETRY, AND PROPER ALIGNMENT ENSURES SAFE HANDLING AND TIRE LONGEVITY. ALSO, TEST DRIVE YOUR VEHICLE GENTLY TO CHECK FOR UNUSUAL NOISES OR HANDLING ISSUES.

TIPS FOR A SMOOTH ROUGH COUNTRY INSTALLATION EXPERIENCE

INSTALLING A LIFT KIT CAN BE REWARDING BUT ALSO CHALLENGING IF YOU'RE UNPREPARED. HERE ARE SOME INSIDER TIPS TO HELP:

- **WORK WITH A BUDDY:** SUSPENSION WORK OFTEN REQUIRES AN EXTRA SET OF HANDS FOR SAFETY AND EASE.
- **USE ANTI-SEIZE LUBRICANT:** APPLY IT TO BOLTS AND METAL CONTACTS TO PREVENT CORROSION AND MAKE FUTURE REMOVAL EASIER.
- **KEEP TRACK OF HARDWARE:** ORGANIZE NUTS, BOLTS, AND WASHERS TO AVOID LOSING ESSENTIAL PARTS.
- **TAKE PHOTOS:** DOCUMENT THE PROCESS STEP-BY-STEP. PHOTOS CAN BE A GREAT REFERENCE IF YOU NEED TO TROUBLESHOOT.
- **FOLLOW TORQUE SPECS PRECISELY:** OVER-TIGHTENING OR UNDER-TIGHTENING BOLTS CAN LEAD TO PREMATURE WEAR

OR SAFETY HAZARDS.

COMMON CHALLENGES AND HOW TO OVERCOME THEM

WHILE ROUGH COUNTRY INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS ARE DESIGNED TO BE USER-FRIENDLY, SOME COMMON OBSTACLES MAY ARISE:

DIFFICULTY REMOVING OLD COMPONENTS

RUST AND CORROSION CAN MAKE BOLTS STUBBORN. USING PENETRATING OIL AND ALLOWING IT TO SOAK FOR SOME TIME CAN HELP LOOSEN THESE FASTENERS. AVOID FORCING PARTS, WHICH MIGHT CAUSE DAMAGE.

MISALIGNMENT AFTER INSTALLATION

IF YOUR VEHICLE PULLS TO ONE SIDE OR THE STEERING FEELS OFF, IT'S LIKELY AN ALIGNMENT ISSUE. TAKE YOUR VEHICLE TO A TRUSTED SHOP FOR ADJUSTMENT AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

UNUSUAL NOISES OR VIBRATIONS

CHECK THAT ALL COMPONENTS ARE SECURELY FASTENED. LOOSE OR IMPROPERLY INSTALLED PARTS CAN CAUSE RATTLING OR VIBRATION DURING DRIVING.

ADDITIONAL CONSIDERATIONS FOR ROUGH COUNTRY LIFT KITS

CHOOSING THE RIGHT ROUGH COUNTRY KIT IS AS IMPORTANT AS THE INSTALLATION ITSELF. CONSIDER THE FOLLOWING:

- **LIFT HEIGHT:** KITS RANGE FROM SMALL 2-INCH LIFTS TO MORE AGGRESSIVE 6-INCH OR HIGHER OPTIONS. BE REALISTIC ABOUT YOUR NEEDS AND LOCAL REGULATIONS.

- **WARRANTY AND SUPPORT:** REGISTER YOUR KIT WITH ROUGH COUNTRY TO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF WARRANTY COVERAGE AND TECHNICAL SUPPORT.
- **ADDITIONAL ACCESSORIES:** SOME LIFT KITS MAY INCLUDE OR RECOMMEND COMPLEMENTARY PRODUCTS LIKE EXTENDED BRAKE LINES, TRACK BARS, OR SWAY BAR END LINKS TO MAINTAIN PROPER FUNCTION.

3. INSTALLING LIFT COMPONENTS

THE CORE OF THE INSTALLATION INVOLVES FITTING ROUGH COUNTRY'S LIFT COMPONENTS. DEPENDING ON THE KIT, THIS MAY INCLUDE SPACERS, COIL SPRINGS, STRUT EXTENSIONS, OR CONTROL ARM DROP BRACKETS. EACH PART HAS SPECIFIC ORIENTATION AND PLACEMENT INSTRUCTIONS, OFTEN ILLUSTRATED WITH DIAGRAMS FOR CLARITY.

TEST-DRIVING THE VEHICLE AT LOW SPEEDS ALLOWS THE INSTALLER TO DETECT ANY UNUSUAL NOISES OR HANDLING ISSUES THAT MAY INDICATE IMPROPER INSTALLATION. IT IS ALSO RECOMMENDED TO SCHEDULE A PROFESSIONAL WHEEL ALIGNMENT TO RESTORE PROPER SUSPENSION GEOMETRY, WHICH IS CRUCIAL FOR TIRE WEAR AND VEHICLE STABILITY.

4. **PERFORM POST-INSTALLATION ALIGNMENT:** ADJUSTING WHEEL ALIGNMENT AFTER INSTALLATION IS CRUCIAL FOR VEHICLE HANDLING AND TIRE LONGEVITY.
5. **DOCUMENT THE PROCESS:** TAKING PHOTOS OR NOTES DURING DISASSEMBLY CAN ASSIST IN REASSEMBLY AND TROUBLESHOOTING.
