- **PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT:** ENCOURAGING PARENTS TO ENGAGE WITH EDUCATIONAL GAMES AT HOME CAN REINFORCE LEARNING.

EDUCATORS AND DEVELOPERS ARE ALSO FOCUSING ON INCLUSIVITY, DESIGNING GAMES THAT REFLECT DIVERSE CULTURAL PERSPECTIVES AND ENCOURAGE CRITICAL ANALYSIS OF HISTORICAL NARRATIVES.

IN THIS DYNAMIC CONTEXT, SOCIAL STUDIES GAMES FOR 5TH GRADE ARE POSITIONED TO BECOME INTEGRAL COMPONENTS OF COMPREHENSIVE SOCIAL STUDIES EDUCATION, FOSTERING BOTH KNOWLEDGE ACQUISITION AND CRITICAL CITIZENSHIP SKILLS IN YOUNG LEARNERS.
