A notorious womanizer, Weber's father was a peripatetic filmmaker who made propaganda and training films for the OSS during World War II before producing the first movie with smells, the regrettable flop that was *AromaRama*. He was as much an enigma to his daughter as he was to the FBI, which had him under surveillance for more than forty years, and even noted Katharine's birth in a memo to J. Edgar Hoover. But the OWI failed to comprehend the large extent by which the war effort would be defined by advertisers and merchandisers. Selling merchandise was the first priority of Tin Pan Alley, and the OWI never swayed them from this course. Kathleen E.R. Smith concludes the government's fears of faltering morale did not materialize. Americans did not need such war songs as Goodbye, Mama, I'm Off To Yokohama, There Are No Wings On a Foxhole, or even The Sun Will Soon Be Setting On The Land Of The Rising Sun to convince them to support the war. The crusade for a proper war song was misguided from the beginning, and the music business, then and now, continues to make huge profits selling love—not war—songs.
