MINES HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT: PROTECTING LIVES IN A HIGH-RISK INDUSTRY

MINES HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT PLAYS A CRUCIAL ROLE IN SAFEGUARDING THE WELL-BEING OF WORKERS IN ONE OF THE MOST HAZARDOUS INDUSTRIES WORLDWIDE. MINING, BY ITS VERY NATURE, INVOLVES SIGNIFICANT RISKS—FROM EXPOSURE TO HARMFUL DUST AND GASES TO THE POSSIBILITY OF CAVE-INS AND EQUIPMENT ACCIDENTS. THE ACT MANDATES STRICT COMPLIANCE MEASURES AND REGULAR INSPECTIONS TO ENSURE THAT MINING SITES ADHERE TO SAFETY STANDARDS.

KEY PROVISIONS OF THE MINES HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT

THE MINES HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT ENCOMPASSES NUMEROUS PROVISIONS DESIGNED TO CREATE A SAFER WORKING ENVIRONMENT. WHILE SPECIFIC DETAILS MAY VARY BY COUNTRY OR REGION, SOME COMMON COMPONENTS ARE UNIVERSALLY EMPHASIZED.

EMPLOYER RESPONSIBILITIES

- PROVIDING ADEQUATE PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)
- REPORTING ACCIDENTS AND DANGEROUS OCCURRENCES PROMPTLY

THESE OBLIGATIONS ENSURE THAT EMPLOYERS ACTIVELY WORK TO PREVENT ACCIDENTS AND HEALTH ISSUES BEFORE THEY

OCCUR.

WORKER RIGHTS AND DUTIES

MINERS THEMSELVES HAVE RIGHTS UNDER THE ACT, SUCH AS THE RIGHT TO REFUSE UNSAFE WORK WITHOUT FEAR OF RETALIATION. THEY ALSO HAVE DUTIES, INCLUDING:

- FOLLOWING SAFETY PROTOCOLS AND INSTRUCTIONS
- USING PROTECTIVE GEAR CORRECTLY
- REPORTING HAZARDS OR UNSAFE CONDITIONS
- PARTICIPATING IN SAFETY TRAINING SESSIONS

THESE MUTUAL RESPONSIBILITIES FOSTER A CULTURE OF SAFETY AND COOPERATION ON MINING SITES.

HEALTH SURVEILLANCE AND MEDICAL EXAMINATIONS

ONE OF THE CRITICAL ASPECTS OF THE MINES HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT IS THE FOCUS ON OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH SURVEILLANCE. MINERS ARE OFTEN EXPOSED TO DUST, NOISE, AND CHEMICALS THAT CAN CAUSE CHRONIC ILLNESSES LIKE PNEUMOCONIOSIS OR HEARING LOSS. THE ACT MANDATES:

- REGULAR MEDICAL EXAMINATIONS BEFORE EMPLOYMENT AND PERIODICALLY DURING EMPLOYMENT
- MONITORING OF EXPOSURE LEVELS TO HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES
- IMPLEMENTING MEASURES TO REDUCE EXPOSURE, SUCH AS VENTILATION SYSTEMS

THIS ENSURES EARLY DETECTION AND PREVENTION OF OCCUPATIONAL DISEASES.

ACCIDENT INVESTIGATION AND REPORTING

IN THE UNFORTUNATE EVENT OF AN ACCIDENT, THE ACT REQUIRES A THOROUGH INVESTIGATION TO IDENTIFY CAUSES AND PREVENT RECURRENCE. KEY ASPECTS INCLUDE:

- IMMEDIATE REPORTING OF ACCIDENTS TO REGULATORY AUTHORITIES
- CONDUCTING INVESTIGATIONS BY QUALIFIED INSPECTORS
- IMPLEMENTING CORRECTIVE ACTIONS BASED ON FINDINGS

THIS PROCESS HELPS IMPROVE MINING SAFETY OVER TIME BY LEARNING FROM PAST INCIDENTS.

THE ROLE OF REGULATORY AUTHORITIES

GOVERNMENT AGENCIES OR MINING INSPECTORATES PLAY A PIVOTAL ROLE IN ENFORCING THE MINES HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT. THEIR DUTIES TYPICALLY INVOLVE:

- CONDUCTING ROUTINE INSPECTIONS AND AUDITS OF MINING SITES
- ISSUING LICENSES AND PERMITS BASED ON COMPLIANCE
- IMPOSING PENALTIES OR SANCTIONS FOR VIOLATIONS
- PROVIDING GUIDANCE AND SUPPORT FOR IMPROVING SAFETY STANDARDS

THESE AUTHORITIES ACT AS WATCHDOGS TO ENSURE THE MINING INDUSTRY OPERATES WITHIN LEGAL SAFETY PARAMETERS.

INSPECTION AND COMPLIANCE MONITORING

TRAINING AND CAPACITY BUILDING

MANY REGULATORY BODIES ALSO FACILITATE TRAINING PROGRAMS FOR MINERS AND MANAGEMENT. THESE INITIATIVES FOCUS ON RAISING AWARENESS OF HEALTH RISKS, PROPER EQUIPMENT USE, AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE PROCEDURES. WELL-TRAINED STAFF ARE CRITICAL TO REDUCING ACCIDENTS AND HEALTH HAZARDS.

IMPORTANCE OF MINES HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT IN MODERN MINING

MINING REMAINS AN ESSENTIAL ECONOMIC ACTIVITY GLOBALLY, SUPPLYING RAW MATERIALS FOR CONSTRUCTION, ENERGY, AND MANUFACTURING. HOWEVER, THE INDUSTRY'S INHERENT DANGERS MAKE HEALTH AND SAFETY REGULATIONS INDISPENSABLE.

REDUCING WORKPLACE ACCIDENTS

THE MINES HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT HAS BEEN INSTRUMENTAL IN LOWERING THE FREQUENCY AND SEVERITY OF MINING ACCIDENTS. BY ENFORCING STRICT SAFETY MEASURES, THE ACT HELPS PREVENT FATALITIES, INJURIES, AND OCCUPATIONAL ILLNESSES. THIS NOT ONLY PROTECTS WORKERS BUT ALSO REDUCES OPERATIONAL DISRUPTIONS AND FINANCIAL LOSSES.

PROMOTING SUSTAINABLE MINING PRACTICES

BEYOND IMMEDIATE SAFETY, THE ACT ENCOURAGES MINING COMPANIES TO ADOPT SUSTAINABLE PRACTICES THAT MINIMIZE ENVIRONMENTAL AND HEALTH IMPACTS. FOR EXAMPLE, MANAGING DUST EMISSIONS AND ENSURING PROPER WASTE DISPOSAL CONTRIBUTE TO HEALTHIER COMMUNITIES AROUND MINING SITES.

ENHANCING WORKER MORALE AND PRODUCTIVITY

WHEN MINERS FEEL SAFE AND VALUED, THEIR JOB SATISFACTION AND PRODUCTIVITY IMPROVE. THE ACT FOSTERS A SAFER AND MORE SUPPORTIVE WORKPLACE CULTURE, WHICH BENEFITS BOTH EMPLOYEES AND EMPLOYERS.

CHALLENGES IN IMPLEMENTING THE MINES HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT

WHILE THE OBJECTIVES OF THE MINES HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT ARE CLEAR, PRACTICAL IMPLEMENTATION CAN FACE HURDLES. SOME COMMON CHALLENGES INCLUDE:

- **RESOURCE LIMITATIONS:** SMALLER MINING COMPANIES MIGHT STRUGGLE TO AFFORD ADVANCED SAFETY EQUIPMENT OR COMPREHENSIVE TRAINING PROGRAMS.

- **TECHNOLOGICAL CONSTRAINTS:** INCORPORATING NEW SAFETY TECHNOLOGIES REQUIRES INVESTMENT AND EXPERTISE THAT NOT ALL OPERATORS POSSESS.

ADDRESSING THESE CHALLENGES REQUIRES COLLABORATION BETWEEN GOVERNMENTS, INDUSTRY STAKEHOLDERS, AND WORKER REPRESENTATIVES.

INNOVATIONS SUPPORTING HEALTH AND SAFETY

ADVANCEMENTS SUCH AS AUTOMATION, REMOTE MONITORING, AND WEARABLE SAFETY DEVICES ARE TRANSFORMING MINING SAFETY. THESE TECHNOLOGIES HELP DETECT HAZARDS IN REAL-TIME AND REDUCE HUMAN EXPOSURE TO DANGEROUS ENVIRONMENTS. INTEGRATING THESE INNOVATIONS WITH THE REGULATIONS OF THE MINES HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT CAN FURTHER ENHANCE WORKER PROTECTION.

TIPS FOR MINING COMPANIES TO COMPLY WITH THE MINES HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT

FOR MINING OPERATORS SEEKING TO ALIGN WITH THE MINES HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT, HERE ARE SOME PRACTICAL TIPS:

1. **CONDUCT REGULAR RISK ASSESSMENTS:** IDENTIFY POTENTIAL HAZARDS AND IMPLEMENT MITIGATION STRATEGIES PROACTIVELY.
2. **INVEST IN TRAINING:** ENSURE ALL WORKERS UNDERSTAND SAFETY PROCEDURES AND THE IMPORTANCE OF COMPLIANCE.
3. **MAINTAIN EQUIPMENT:** REGULAR INSPECTIONS AND MAINTENANCE PREVENT MALFUNCTIONS THAT CAN CAUSE ACCIDENTS.
4. **ENGAGE EMPLOYEES:** ENCOURAGE WORKERS TO REPORT UNSAFE CONDITIONS AND PARTICIPATE IN SAFETY COMMITTEES.
5. **STAY UPDATED:** KEEP ABREAST OF CHANGES IN LEGISLATION AND BEST PRACTICES IN MINE SAFETY.

ADHERING TO THESE GUIDELINES NOT ONLY FULFILLS LEGAL OBLIGATIONS BUT ALSO FOSTERS A CULTURE OF SAFETY.

MINING IS UNDENIABLY A CHALLENGING AND HIGH-RISK INDUSTRY, BUT WITH THE MINES HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT AS A GUIDING FRAMEWORK, IT IS POSSIBLE TO PROTECT THE LIVES AND HEALTH OF THOSE WHO POWER THIS VITAL SECTOR. BY UNDERSTANDING AND IMPLEMENTING THE ACT'S PROVISIONS, MINING COMPANIES CONTRIBUTE TO SAFER WORKPLACES AND MORE SUSTAINABLE OPERATIONS, ULTIMATELY BENEFITING WORKERS, COMMUNITIES, AND THE ECONOMY AT LARGE.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT IS THE PRIMARY PURPOSE OF THE MINES HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT?

THE PRIMARY PURPOSE OF THE MINES HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT IS TO ENSURE THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OF EMPLOYEES WORKING IN MINING OPERATIONS BY REGULATING WORKPLACE CONDITIONS, SAFETY PRACTICES, AND ACCIDENT PREVENTION MEASURES.

WHO IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ENFORCING THE MINES HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT?

THE ENFORCEMENT OF THE MINES HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF MINERAL RESOURCES AND ENERGY OR THE RELEVANT GOVERNMENTAL MINING SAFETY AUTHORITY, WHICH CONDUCTS INSPECTIONS AND ENSURES COMPLIANCE.

WHAT ARE SOME KEY SAFETY REQUIREMENTS OUTLINED IN THE MINES HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT?

KEY SAFETY REQUIREMENTS INCLUDE RISK ASSESSMENTS, MANDATORY SAFETY TRAINING, PROVISION OF PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE), EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS, REPORTING OF ACCIDENTS, AND IMPLEMENTATION OF SAFETY MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS IN MINING OPERATIONS.

WHAT PENALTIES EXIST FOR NON-COMPLIANCE WITH THE MINES HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT?

PENALTIES FOR NON-COMPLIANCE CAN INCLUDE FINES, SUSPENSION OF MINING OPERATIONS, LEGAL ACTION AGAINST RESPONSIBLE INDIVIDUALS OR COMPANIES, AND IN SEVERE CASES, IMPRISONMENT FOR VIOLATIONS THAT LEAD TO SERIOUS INJURY OR DEATH.

HOW OFTEN ARE SAFETY AUDITS REQUIRED UNDER THE MINES HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT?

SAFETY AUDITS AND INSPECTIONS ARE REQUIRED REGULARLY, OFTEN ANNUALLY OR MORE FREQUENTLY DEPENDING ON THE RISK LEVEL OF THE MINING OPERATION, TO ENSURE ONGOING COMPLIANCE WITH HEALTH AND SAFETY STANDARDS.

UNDERSTANDING THE MINES HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT

AT ITS CORE, THE MINES HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT EMBODIES A SET OF LEGAL REQUIREMENTS THAT MINING COMPANIES MUST ADHERE TO IN ORDER TO PROMOTE A SAFE WORKING ENVIRONMENT. IT TYPICALLY ENCOMPASSES REGULATIONS ON WORKPLACE SAFETY MEASURES, RISK ASSESSMENTS, EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS, AND WORKER TRAINING. BY IMPOSING STRINGENT CONTROLS ON MINING PRACTICES, THE ACT AIMS TO REDUCE FATALITIES AND INJURIES, WHICH HISTORICALLY HAVE BEEN ALARMINGLY HIGH WITHIN THE SECTOR.

THE ACT IS NOT A STATIC DOCUMENT; IT EVOLVES IN RESPONSE TO TECHNOLOGICAL ADVANCEMENTS, INDUSTRY TRENDS, AND EMERGING HEALTH RISKS. FOR EXAMPLE, CONTEMPORARY UPDATES OFTEN ADDRESS EXPOSURE LIMITS TO HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES LIKE SILICA DUST AND NOISE POLLUTION, REFLECTING GROWING AWARENESS OF OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH CONCERNS.

KEY PROVISIONS AND FEATURES

THE MINES HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT GENERALLY INCLUDES SEVERAL CRITICAL PROVISIONS THAT MINING COMPANIES MUST IMPLEMENT:

- **RISK MANAGEMENT AND HAZARD IDENTIFICATION:** MINING OPERATIONS ARE REQUIRED TO CONDUCT THOROUGH RISK ASSESSMENTS TO IDENTIFY POTENTIAL HAZARDS—RANGING FROM STRUCTURAL COLLAPSES TO CHEMICAL EXPOSURES—AND ESTABLISH CONTROL MEASURES.
- **WORKER TRAINING AND COMPETENCE:** THE ACT MANDATES COMPREHENSIVE TRAINING PROGRAMS ENSURING THAT ALL EMPLOYEES UNDERSTAND SAFETY PROTOCOLS, EMERGENCY PROCEDURES, AND EQUIPMENT OPERATION.
- **HEALTH SURVEILLANCE AND MONITORING:** REGULAR MEDICAL EXAMINATIONS AND MONITORING FOR OCCUPATIONAL DISEASES HELP IN EARLY DETECTION AND INTERVENTION.
- **REPORTING AND INVESTIGATION OF INCIDENTS:** ALL ACCIDENTS, NEAR-MISSES, AND UNSAFE CONDITIONS MUST BE REPORTED AND INVESTIGATED TO PREVENT RECURRENCE.
- **SAFETY COMMITTEES AND WORKER PARTICIPATION:** ENCOURAGING WORKER INVOLVEMENT IN SAFETY MATTERS FOSTERS A CULTURE OF SHARED RESPONSIBILITY.

THESE PROVISIONS COLLECTIVELY CREATE A ROBUST SAFETY NET DESIGNED TO PROTECT WORKERS AND MINIMIZE OPERATIONAL DISRUPTIONS CAUSED BY ACCIDENTS OR HEALTH-RELATED ABSENCES.

THE IMPACT OF THE MINES HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT ON THE MINING

INDUSTRY

IMPLEMENTING THE MINES HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT HAS TANGIBLE BENEFITS AND CHALLENGES FOR MINING ENTERPRISES. ON ONE HAND, ADHERING TO THE ACT'S STANDARDS REDUCES THE INCIDENCE OF WORKPLACE ACCIDENTS, THEREBY LOWERING COMPENSATION CLAIMS, LEGAL LIABILITIES, AND REPUTATIONAL DAMAGE. MINING COMPANIES THAT PRIORITIZE HEALTH AND SAFETY OFTEN REPORT IMPROVED PRODUCTIVITY SINCE A HEALTHY WORKFORCE IS MORE EFFICIENT AND MOTIVATED.

CONVERSELY, COMPLIANCE CAN ENTAIL SIGNIFICANT COSTS. INVESTMENTS IN SAFETY INFRASTRUCTURE, TRAINING, AND MONITORING SYSTEMS REQUIRE CAPITAL OUTLAY. SMALLER MINING OPERATIONS MAY FIND THESE REQUIREMENTS PARTICULARLY BURDENSOME. HOWEVER, NON-COMPLIANCE RISKS FAR GREATER FINANCIAL PENALTIES AND OPERATIONAL SHUTDOWNS.

COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS: GLOBAL STANDARDS AND LOCAL REGULATIONS

WHILE THE MINES HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT PROVIDES THE REGULATORY BACKBONE WITHIN SPECIFIC JURISDICTIONS, IT OFTEN ALIGNS WITH INTERNATIONAL STANDARDS SUCH AS THOSE PROMULGATED BY THE INTERNATIONAL LABOUR ORGANIZATION (ILO) AND THE WORLD HEALTH ORGANIZATION (WHO). FOR INSTANCE, THE ILO'S MINING CONVENTION (No. 176) OFFERS A FRAMEWORK THAT MANY COUNTRIES ADAPT TO THEIR LOCAL LEGISLATIVE CONTEXT.

COMPARING DIFFERENT COUNTRIES REVEALS VARIATIONS IN ENFORCEMENT RIGOR AND SCOPE. DEVELOPED NATIONS TEND TO HAVE MORE COMPREHENSIVE LEGISLATION AND STRONGER ENFORCEMENT MECHANISMS, BACKED BY ADVANCED TECHNOLOGY AND RESOURCES. IN CONTRAST, DEVELOPING COUNTRIES MAY STRUGGLE WITH IMPLEMENTATION DUE TO LIMITED INFRASTRUCTURE AND REGULATORY OVERSIGHT.

NEVERTHELESS, THE UNIVERSAL GOAL REMAINS CONSISTENT: SAFEGUARDING MINERS' HEALTH AND SAFETY WHILE BALANCING ECONOMIC VIABILITY.

CHALLENGES AND LIMITATIONS OF THE MINES HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT

DESPITE ITS CRITICAL ROLE, THE MINES HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT FACES SEVERAL CHALLENGES THAT CAN UNDERMINE ITS EFFECTIVENESS:

- **ENFORCEMENT GAPS:** INSUFFICIENT INSPECTION PERSONNEL AND RESOURCE CONSTRAINTS OFTEN LEAD TO LAPSES IN MONITORING COMPLIANCE.
- **INFORMAL AND SMALL-SCALE MINING:** THESE SECTORS FREQUENTLY OPERATE OUTSIDE FORMAL REGULATORY FRAMEWORKS, INCREASING RISKS FOR WORKERS.
- **TECHNOLOGICAL LIMITATIONS:** IN SOME REGIONS, OUTDATED EQUIPMENT AND LACK OF SAFETY TECHNOLOGY HINDER FULL COMPLIANCE.
- **CULTURAL AND BEHAVIORAL FACTORS:** RESISTANCE TO SAFETY PROTOCOLS AMONG WORKERS OR MANAGEMENT CAN IMPEDE THE ACT'S IMPLEMENTATION.

ADDRESSING THESE LIMITATIONS REQUIRES A MULTIFACETED APPROACH INVOLVING GOVERNMENT AGENCIES, INDUSTRY STAKEHOLDERS, AND WORKER REPRESENTATIVES TO FOSTER A CULTURE OF SAFETY THAT TRANSCENDS WRITTEN LAWS.

TECHNOLOGICAL INNOVATIONS ENHANCING COMPLIANCE

IN RECENT YEARS, TECHNOLOGICAL ADVANCEMENTS HAVE PLAYED A TRANSFORMATIVE ROLE IN SUPPORTING THE MINES HEALTH

AND SAFETY ACT'S OBJECTIVES. INNOVATIONS SUCH AS REAL-TIME ENVIRONMENTAL MONITORING, WEARABLE SAFETY DEVICES, AND AUTOMATION REDUCE HUMAN EXPOSURE TO HAZARDOUS CONDITIONS.

FOR EXAMPLE, THE INTEGRATION OF SENSORS TO DETECT GAS LEAKS OR STRUCTURAL INSTABILITIES ALLOWS FOR IMMEDIATE ALERTS, PREVENTING ACCIDENTS. SIMILARLY, VIRTUAL REALITY TRAINING MODULES PROVIDE IMMERSIVE SAFETY EDUCATION WITHOUT EXPOSING WORKERS TO ACTUAL RISKS.

THESE TECHNOLOGIES NOT ONLY IMPROVE COMPLIANCE BUT ALSO REPRESENT PROACTIVE MEASURES IN THE CONTINUOUS EVOLUTION OF MINING SAFETY STANDARDS.

THE ROLE OF STAKEHOLDERS IN UPHOLDING THE MINES HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT

SUCCESSFUL IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MINES HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT DEPENDS ON ACTIVE PARTICIPATION ACROSS MULTIPLE STAKEHOLDERS:

1. **GOVERNMENT REGULATORS:** RESPONSIBLE FOR ENACTING LAWS, CONDUCTING INSPECTIONS, AND ENFORCING PENALTIES FOR NON-COMPLIANCE.
2. **MINING COMPANIES:** MUST ALLOCATE RESOURCES, DEVELOP SAFETY POLICIES, AND FOSTER A SAFETY-FIRST CULTURE.
3. **WORKERS AND UNIONS:** SERVE AS FRONTLINE DEFENDERS OF SAFE PRACTICES, REPORTING HAZARDS AND PARTICIPATING IN SAFETY COMMITTEES.
4. **COMMUNITY AND ENVIRONMENTAL GROUPS:** ADVOCATE FOR RESPONSIBLE MINING PRACTICES THAT PROTECT NOT ONLY WORKERS BUT SURROUNDING COMMUNITIES AND ECOSYSTEMS.

THIS COLLABORATIVE DYNAMIC IS ESSENTIAL FOR TRANSLATING LEGISLATIVE INTENT INTO TANGIBLE SAFETY OUTCOMES ON THE GROUND.

FUTURE DIRECTIONS AND POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

LOOKING AHEAD, THE MINES HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT WILL LIKELY EVOLVE TO ADDRESS EMERGING CHALLENGES SUCH AS CLIMATE CHANGE IMPACTS, MENTAL HEALTH ISSUES AMONG MINERS, AND INCREASING AUTOMATION. POLICYMAKERS MAY ALSO EXPLORE INTEGRATING SUSTAINABILITY METRICS WITH SAFETY STANDARDS, REFLECTING A HOLISTIC APPROACH TO MINING GOVERNANCE.

MOREOVER, GLOBAL TRENDS TOWARD CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY AND ENVIRONMENTAL, SOCIAL, AND GOVERNANCE (ESG) CRITERIA PLACE ADDITIONAL PRESSURE ON MINING COMPANIES TO EXCEED MERE COMPLIANCE AND DEMONSTRATE LEADERSHIP IN HEALTH AND SAFETY.

ULTIMATELY, THE MINES HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT REMAINS A VITAL INSTRUMENT—NOT ONLY FOR RISK MITIGATION BUT ALSO FOR PROMOTING ETHICAL AND SUSTAINABLE MINING PRACTICES WORLDWIDE.
