The songs are rare and specific examples of the widespread practice of inter-genre borrowing and musical arrangement that was fundamental to minstrelsy. Grounded in Abenaki culture, Savageau questions cultural definitions of madness and charts a path to recovery through a combination of medications, psychotherapy, and ceremony.
