Answer: Turn on the first switch and leave it on for a few minutes. Then, turn it off and immediately turn on the second switch. Enter the bulb room. The bulb that is on corresponds to the second switch. The bulb that is off but warm corresponds to the first switch (because it was recently on). The bulb that is off and cold corresponds to the third switch.

Question 2: The River Crossing

A farmer has a wolf, a goat, and a cabbage. He needs to cross a river with a boat that can carry only himself and one item at a time. If left alone, the wolf will eat the goat, and the goat will eat the cabbage. How can he get all three across safely?

Answer: The farmer first takes the goat across. He returns alone and takes the wolf across. He leaves the wolf on the other side but takes the goat back. Then, he takes the cabbage across and leaves it with the wolf. Finally, he returns alone to get the goat.

Question 3: The Missing Dollar

Three friends check into a hotel room that costs \$30. They split the cost and each pays \$10. Later, the hotel realizes the room was only \$25 and gives \$5 to the bellboy to return. The bellboy can't split \$5 evenly and gives each friend \$1 back and keeps \$2. Now each friend has paid \$9, totaling \$27, plus \$2 with the bellboy equals \$29. Where is the missing dollar?

Answer: This is a trick question. The \$2 kept by the bellboy is part of the \$27 the friends paid. The correct addition is \$25 (hotel) + \$2 (bellboy) + \$3 (returned to friends) = \$30. The confusion arises because the \$2 is incorrectly added rather than subtracted.
