Using basic algebra we know that the equation for a line is of the form $y = sx + b$, where $\mathbf{F} = y$ and $\mathbf{a} = x$, s is the slope of the line and b is the y intercept when $x = 0$. In our case $b = 0$ because when $\mathbf{F} = 0$, $\mathbf{a} = 0$; as observed. If the observer then applies various forces to the object and measures the resulting acceleration, an X-Y plot of the resulting data will show a line of the form $y = sx + b$ or in this case $\mathbf{F} = s\mathbf{a}$. Knowing that we have $\mathbf{F}$ for each $\mathbf{a}$, we can calculate ' s ' by dividing $\mathbf{F}$ by $\mathbf{a}$; $s = \mathbf{F}/\mathbf{a}$.
