WHAT IS THE GAY HANKY CODE?

UNDERSTANDING THE COLORS: COMMON HANKY MEANINGS

BECAUSE THE GAY HANKY CODE EVOLVED ORGANICALLY OVER TIME, THERE ARE VARIATIONS AND REGIONAL DIFFERENCES. HOWEVER, CERTAIN COLORS HAVE BECOME WIDELY RECOGNIZED WITHIN THE COMMUNITY. HERE'S AN OVERVIEW OF SOME OF THE MOST COMMON HANKY COLORS AND WHAT THEY TRADITIONALLY SIGNIFY:

RED

BLACK IS COMMONLY LINKED TO SM (SADOMASOCHISM) OR BDSM (BONDAGE, DISCIPLINE, DOMINANCE, SUBMISSION, SADISM, MASOCHISM) ACTIVITIES. AGAIN, LEFT SIDE SIGNALS DOMINANCE OR THE GIVER ROLE, AND RIGHT SIDE SUGGESTS SUBMISSION OR THE RECEIVER.

YELLOW

YELLOW HANKIES SYMBOLIZE WATER SPORTS OR UROLAGNIA, WHICH INVOLVES SEXUAL ACTIVITIES RELATED TO URINE. THIS COLOR IS LESS COMMON BUT HAS A STRONG PRESENCE IN THE CODE.

LIGHT BLUE

LIGHT BLUE REPRESENTS ORAL SEX. A LEFT-SIDE WEARER IS TYPICALLY THE GIVER, WHILE THE RIGHT SIDE INDICATES THE RECEIVER.

GREEN

GREEN MEANS MARIJUANA OR CANNABIS USE, OFTEN SIGNALING SOMEONE INTERESTED IN SHARING OR INDULGING IN THIS ACTIVITY SOCIALLY OR SEXUALLY.

GRAY

GRAY IS USED TO INDICATE BONDAGE INTERESTS. LIKE OTHER COLORS, THE SIDE WORN COMMUNICATES DOMINANT OR SUBMISSIVE PREFERENCES.

ORANGE

ORANGE IS ASSOCIATED WITH ANYTHING RELATED TO ANAL PLAY, INCLUDING ANAL SEX OR PROSTATE STIMULATION. THE SIDE OF THE HANKY AGAIN SIGNALS WHETHER THE WEARER PREFERS TO GIVE OR RECEIVE.

THE IMPORTANCE OF PLACEMENT: LEFT VS. RIGHT

THE GAY HANKY COLOR GUIDE ISN'T JUST ABOUT COLOR—IT'S ALSO ABOUT PLACEMENT. UNDERSTANDING THIS ASPECT IS KEY TO INTERPRETING THE CODE CORRECTLY.

COLOR PLACEMENT AND ITS ROLE IN COMMUNICATION

THE SPATIAL ASPECT OF THE HANKY CODE—SPECIFICALLY THE LEFT VERSUS RIGHT POCKET PLACEMENT—IS AS CRUCIAL AS THE COLOR ITSELF.
