The book presents a variety of situations - many of them about animals and farming - so that students will have some fun as they look for and discover the solutions. Mathy the Mammoth, with his obsession with blueberries, is featured several times, and students will also go hiking and traveling around the world. There are also some challenging word problems (marked as such) and interesting puzzle corners. Some worksheets have examples and some instruction related to problem solving. Students are often encouraged to write down the calculations they do. I suggest that you also encourage your student(s) to make a drawing or a sketch of the situation in the problem (if applicable), to help them understand the situation and to see what math operation is involved. Overall, the problems in this collection require multiple steps, with the exception of question #1 in worksheet Division Warm-Up, as it focuses on differentiating what math operation should be used.
