SIMILAR IN TONE TO THE WORKS OF AUTHORS LIKE JOHN BERGER AND ANNIE DILLARD, SEBALD'S NARRATIVE EMPHASIZES OBSERVATION AND REFLECTION OVER PLOT-DRIVEN STORYTELLING. HOWEVER, HIS UNIQUE BLEND OF HISTORICAL INQUIRY AND PERSONAL MEDITATION SETS HIS WORK APART IN CONTEMPORARY LITERATURE.
