I wanted to satisfy their lusts, as God satisfied the Israelites' lusts by giving them quails (Numbers 11). If we take red letters to its logical conclusion, then who needs the black ones? Yet Paul says, All scripture is given by inspiration of God (2 Timothy 3:16). Therefore, the black letters do matter. They give context, if nothing else. For example, to whom did Jesus say follow me (Matthew 4:19, 9:9, 19:21; Mark 2:14, 10:21; Luke 5:27, 18:22; John 1:43, 21:19)? Only the black letters can tell us. Still, what surprises me is how much spiritual force Jesus' words actually have. The sermons and letters of Paul, for example, don't have the same force. The Jesus who said let not thy left hand know what thy right hand doeth (Matthew 6:3) also said if thy right hand offend thee, cut it off (5:30). Again, the Jesus

who said love your enemies (Luke 6:27) also said those mine enemies, which would not that I should reign over them, bring hither, and slay them before me (19:27). This contrast tells me that Jesus took eternity (heaven and hell) and submission to his authority just as seriously as charity and love. For the red letters, I copied content verbatim from e-Sword's King James Version (KJV), except where it disagreed with Thomas Nelson's print KJV. Wherever I found disagreement, I deferred to the print Bible. In order to create narrative flow, I removed chapter headings and verses and made each sentence a separate paragraph, so there are minor punctuation changes. Translations of Aramaic and Hebrew words are in parentheses. Words of Jesus in someone else's mouth are in brackets. Old Testament quotations are italicized. Appendices are two-pronged. Lexicons consist of the body, communication and education, economics, food and drink, law politics and religion, marriage and family, nature, and miscellaneous (e.g. colors). Miscellaneous consists of concepts, Old Testament quotations and references, people, and places. Unlike heaven and earth, Jesus' words are eternal (Matthew 24:35, Mark 13:31, Luke 21:33). May we learn to listen and obey.
