TEACHERS CAN USE THESE ANSWERS AS A SPRINGBOARD TO DISCUSS TOPICS SUCH AS COLONIAL RIVALRIES, NATIVE AMERICAN DIPLOMACY, AND THE ORIGINS OF AMERICAN INDEPENDENCE MOVEMENTS.

ADDITIONALLY, STUDENTS CAN BE ENCOURAGED TO RELATE THE MATERIAL TO MODERN GEOPOLITICAL CONFLICTS, IDENTIFYING PATTERNS OF ALLIANCE-BUILDING, TERRITORIAL DISPUTES, AND ECONOMIC MOTIVATIONS. THIS LINKAGE MAKES HISTORY RELEVANT AND FOSTERS CRITICAL GLOBAL AWARENESS.

EFFECTIVE STUDY STRATEGIES USING THE GUIDED READING ANSWERS
