The music is in the mind of the learner and in the sounds produced through the mind to the fingers to the keyboard and back again. Second, this book builds on the traditions of the past. It is not that all of the books, instructors and past methods are wrong. But it does mean that they may have fallen short of the goals they reflected. Third, this book is based on how learners learn; not just on how notes, scales, and chords are presented. Many of the past books assume that it is up to the learner to fill in the blanks. Throughout the book, there will be found explanations on how to learn and what happens when a person is learning new information.
