THE FOUNDING VISION: THOMAS JEFFERSON'S DREAM

WHEN EXPLORING THE HISTORY OF THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA, IT'S IMPOSSIBLE TO OVERLOOK THE PROFOUND ROLE THOMAS JEFFERSON PLAYED. JEFFERSON, THE THIRD PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES AND AUTHOR OF THE DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE, SOUGHT TO CREATE A UNIVERSITY UNLIKE ANY OTHER IN AMERICA AT THE TIME. HE ENVISIONED AN INSTITUTION FREE FROM RELIGIOUS INFLUENCE, WHERE STUDENTS COULD PURSUE KNOWLEDGE IN A BROAD ARRAY OF DISCIPLINES.

JEFFERSON'S IDEA WAS REVOLUTIONARY. UNLIKE COLONIAL COLLEGES THAT WERE TIED TO CHURCH DOCTRINES, THE UNIVERSITY WAS MEANT TO BE A SECULAR PLACE OF LEARNING. HE BELIEVED THAT EDUCATION WAS THE FOUNDATION OF A THRIVING DEMOCRACY AND THAT AN INFORMED CITIZENRY WAS ESSENTIAL TO THE COUNTRY'S FUTURE. IN 1819, AFTER YEARS OF PLANNING AND ADVOCACY, THE STATE OF VIRGINIA OFFICIALLY CHARTERED THE UNIVERSITY.

DESIGN AND ARCHITECTURE: MORE THAN JUST A CAMPUS

ONE OF THE MOST STRIKING ASPECTS OF THE UNIVERSITY'S HISTORY IS ITS ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN, WHICH JEFFERSON PERSONALLY OVERSAW. HE DESIGNED THE CAMPUS TO REFLECT CLASSICAL ROMAN IDEALS, FOCUSING ON HARMONY, SYMMETRY, AND BEAUTY. THE CENTERPIECE IS THE ICONIC ROTUNDA, INSPIRED BY THE PANTHEON IN ROME, SYMBOLIZING THE PURSUIT OF KNOWLEDGE.

JEFFERSON'S "ACADEMICAL VILLAGE" CONCEPT INTEGRATED LIVING AND LEARNING SPACES, WITH FACULTY AND STUDENTS RESIDING IN PAVILIONS SURROUNDING THE LAWN. THIS INNOVATIVE DESIGN FOSTERED A CLOSE-KNIT INTELLECTUAL COMMUNITY, ENCOURAGING DIALOGUE AND COLLABORATION. TODAY, THE LAWN AND ROTUNDA ARE RECOGNIZED AS A UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE SITE, UNDERSCORING THEIR CULTURAL AND HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE.

EARLY YEARS AND GROWTH

THE UNIVERSITY OPENED ITS DOORS TO STUDENTS IN 1825, WELCOMING A MODEST INITIAL CLASS. THE EARLY CURRICULUM WAS BROAD, ENCOMPASSING SUBJECTS SUCH AS LAW, MEDICINE, PHILOSOPHY, AND THE SCIENCES, REFLECTING JEFFERSON'S COMMITMENT TO A WELL-ROUNDED EDUCATION. THE UNIVERSITY QUICKLY GAINED A REPUTATION FOR ACADEMIC RIGOR AND PROGRESSIVE TEACHING METHODS.

HOWEVER, THE EARLY HISTORY OF THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA WAS NOT WITHOUT CHALLENGES. FINANCIAL DIFFICULTIES AND POLITICAL TURMOIL OCCASIONALLY THREATENED ITS STABILITY. DESPITE THESE HURDLES, THE INSTITUTION PERSEVERED, GRADUALLY EXPANDING ITS FACULTIES AND INFRASTRUCTURE THROUGHOUT THE 19TH CENTURY.

THE CIVIL WAR ERA AND ITS IMPACT

THE AMERICAN CIVIL WAR WAS A TURBULENT PERIOD FOR THE UNIVERSITY, DEEPLY AFFECTING ITS OPERATIONS AND STUDENT BODY. MANY STUDENTS AND FACULTY MEMBERS LEFT TO SERVE IN THE CONFEDERATE FORCES, AND THE CAMPUS ITSELF WAS

REPURPOSED AS A HOSPITAL FOR WOUNDED SOLDIERS. THE WAR CAUSED SIGNIFICANT DISRUPTION, AND POST-WAR RECOVERY WAS SLOW.

NEVERTHELESS, THE UNIVERSITY EMERGED FROM THE CONFLICT DETERMINED TO REBUILD AND MODERNIZE. THE RECONSTRUCTION PERIOD SAW RENEWED EFFORTS TO EXPAND ACADEMIC PROGRAMS AND FACILITIES, SETTING THE STAGE FOR FUTURE GROWTH.

TRANSFORMATION IN THE 20TH CENTURY

THE 20TH CENTURY MARKED A TIME OF SIGNIFICANT TRANSFORMATION FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA. IT EVOLVED FROM A REGIONAL INSTITUTION INTO A NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED UNIVERSITY. THIS PERIOD WITNESSED THE INTRODUCTION OF NEW SCHOOLS AND DISCIPLINES, INCLUDING ENGINEERING, BUSINESS, AND EDUCATION.

INTEGRATION AND SOCIAL CHANGE

THIS WAS A COURAGEOUS STEP TOWARD INCLUSIVITY, REFLECTING BROADER SOCIAL CHANGES SWEEPING ACROSS THE UNITED STATES.

THE UNIVERSITY CONTINUED TO GROW MORE DIVERSE AND INCLUSIVE OVER THE DECADES, REFLECTING EVOLVING SOCIETAL VALUES AND EXPANDING OPPORTUNITIES FOR ALL STUDENTS.

ADVANCEMENTS IN RESEARCH AND ACADEMICS

THROUGHOUT THE 20TH CENTURY, THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA DISTINGUISHED ITSELF THROUGH CUTTING-EDGE RESEARCH AND ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE. IT ESTABLISHED NUMEROUS RESEARCH CENTERS AND INSTITUTES, CONTRIBUTING TO ADVANCEMENTS IN MEDICINE, TECHNOLOGY, AND THE HUMANITIES. THE UNIVERSITY'S COMMITMENT TO INTERDISCIPLINARY STUDIES FOSTERED INNOVATION AND COLLABORATION AMONG FACULTY AND STUDENTS ALIKE.

THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA TODAY

TODAY, THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA STANDS AS A VIBRANT ACADEMIC COMMUNITY, BALANCING RESPECT FOR ITS RICH HISTORY WITH A FORWARD-LOOKING VISION. IT OFFERS A DIVERSE RANGE OF UNDERGRADUATE, GRADUATE, AND PROFESSIONAL PROGRAMS, ATTRACTING STUDENTS FROM AROUND THE GLOBE.

PRESERVING TRADITION WHILE EMBRACING INNOVATION

ONE OF THE REMARKABLE ASPECTS OF THE UNIVERSITY'S CURRENT IDENTITY IS ITS ABILITY TO HONOR JEFFERSON'S ORIGINAL VISION WHILE ADAPTING TO CONTEMPORARY NEEDS. THE ACADEMICAL VILLAGE REMAINS THE HEART OF THE CAMPUS, BUT MODERN FACILITIES AND TECHNOLOGIES SUPPORT CUTTING-EDGE RESEARCH AND LEARNING.

THE UNIVERSITY ALSO PLACES A STRONG EMPHASIS ON PUBLIC SERVICE AND CIVIC ENGAGEMENT, CARRYING FORWARD JEFFERSON'S BELIEF IN EDUCATION AS A PILLAR OF DEMOCRACY.

WHEN WAS THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA FOUNDED?

THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA WAS FOUNDED IN 1819 BY THOMAS JEFFERSON.

WHO WAS THE FOUNDER OF THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA?

THOMAS JEFFERSON, THE THIRD PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, FOUNDED THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA.

WHAT WAS THOMAS JEFFERSON'S VISION FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA?

THOMAS JEFFERSON ENVISIONED THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA AS AN INSTITUTION DEDICATED TO PUBLIC EDUCATION, FREE FROM RELIGIOUS INFLUENCE, AND DESIGNED TO CULTIVATE AN INFORMED AND ENLIGHTENED CITIZENRY.

WHAT IS SIGNIFICANT ABOUT THE ARCHITECTURE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA?

THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA IS RENOWNED FOR ITS JEFFERSONIAN ARCHITECTURE, ESPECIALLY THE ROTUNDA, MODELED AFTER THE ROMAN PANTHEON, WHICH IS A UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE SITE.

HOW DID THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA CONTRIBUTE TO HIGHER EDUCATION IN THE UNITED STATES?

THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA WAS ONE OF THE FIRST UNIVERSITIES TO ADOPT THE ELECTIVE SYSTEM, ALLOWING STUDENTS TO CHOOSE THEIR COURSES, AND IT EMPHASIZED SECULAR EDUCATION, INFLUENCING MODERN AMERICAN HIGHER EDUCATION.

WHAT ROLE DID THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA PLAY DURING THE AMERICAN CIVIL

WAR?

DURING THE CIVIL WAR, THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA'S BUILDINGS WERE USED AS A HOSPITAL FOR CONFEDERATE SOLDIERS, AND THE UNIVERSITY TEMPORARILY SUSPENDED CLASSES DUE TO THE CONFLICT.

WHEN DID THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA BECOME COEDUCATIONAL?

THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA BEGAN ADMITTING WOMEN AS FULL-TIME STUDENTS IN 1970, TRANSITIONING TO A COEDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION.

ADDITIONAL RESOURCES

HISTORY OF THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA: A LEGACY OF INNOVATION AND EDUCATION

HISTORY OF THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA IS A NARRATIVE DEEPLY INTERTWINED WITH THE VISION OF ITS FOUNDER, THOMAS JEFFERSON, AND THE BROADER DEVELOPMENT OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN THE UNITED STATES. ESTABLISHED IN THE EARLY 19TH CENTURY, THE UNIVERSITY REPRESENTS A PIONEERING MODEL OF LEARNING THAT DIVERGED SHARPLY FROM TRADITIONAL COLONIAL COLLEGES. AS ONE OF AMERICA'S OLDEST INSTITUTIONS, THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA (UVA) STANDS AS A TESTAMENT TO THE ENLIGHTENMENT IDEALS OF KNOWLEDGE, DEMOCRACY, AND PUBLIC SERVICE, WHICH CONTINUE TO SHAPE ITS MISSION TODAY.

FOUNDING AND EARLY YEARS

THE HISTORY OF THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA BEGINS IN 1819, WHEN THOMAS JEFFERSON, THE THIRD PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES AND AUTHOR OF THE DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE, SOUGHT TO CREATE A NEW KIND OF UNIVERSITY. UNLIKE THE RELIGIOUSLY AFFILIATED COLLEGES OF THE TIME, JEFFERSON ENVISIONED A SECULAR INSTITUTION COMMITTED TO THE PURSUIT OF KNOWLEDGE IN THE SCIENCES, HUMANITIES, AND ARTS WITHOUT ECCLESIASTICAL OVERSIGHT. HIS PLAN WAS REVOLUTIONARY: THE UNIVERSITY WOULD BE GOVERNED BY A BOARD OF VISITORS AND DESIGNED TO FOSTER FREE INQUIRY AND INTELLECTUAL RIGOR.

CONSTRUCTION OF THE CAMPUS BEGAN IN 1817 ON A SITE IN CHARLOTTESVILLE, VIRGINIA. JEFFERSON PERSONALLY DESIGNED THE ACADEMICAL VILLAGE, A COMPLEX OF PAVILIONS, STUDENT ROOMS, AND OPEN SPACES ARRANGED AROUND THE ICONIC ROTUNDA, MODELED AFTER THE PANTHEON IN ROME. THIS ARCHITECTURAL LAYOUT SYMBOLIZED THE UNITY OF LEARNING AND COMMUNITY, A CONCEPT THAT WAS AHEAD OF ITS TIME IN AMERICAN HIGHER EDUCATION.

INNOVATIONS IN EDUCATION

THE UNIVERSITY'S CURRICULUM BROKE NEW GROUND BY OFFERING SPECIALIZED FACULTIES, INCLUDING LAW, MEDICINE, AND PHILOSOPHY, RATHER THAN A SINGLE, CLASSICAL CURRICULUM. IT WAS AMONG THE FIRST INSTITUTIONS TO IMPLEMENT ELECTIVE COURSES, ALLOWING STUDENTS TO TAILOR THEIR EDUCATION ACCORDING TO THEIR INTERESTS AND CAREER GOALS. THIS FLEXIBILITY CONTRASTED SHARPLY WITH THE RIGID CURRICULA OF CONTEMPORANEOUS COLLEGES AND REFLECTED JEFFERSON'S BELIEF IN EDUCATION AS A MEANS TO CULTIVATE INFORMED CITIZENS.

IN ADDITION, UVA'S COMMITMENT TO PUBLIC SERVICE AND DEMOCRATIC IDEALS WAS EVIDENT IN ITS ADMISSIONS POLICIES AND GOVERNANCE STRUCTURE. IT WAS ONE OF THE EARLIEST PUBLIC UNIVERSITIES IN THE UNITED STATES, EMPHASIZING ACCESSIBILITY FOR VIRGINIANS RATHER THAN CATERING EXCLUSIVELY TO THE ELITE. THE UNIVERSITY'S MOTTO, "VERITAS," LATIN FOR "TRUTH," ENCAPSULATES ITS DEDICATION TO INTELLECTUAL HONESTY AND CRITICAL THINKING.

GROWTH THROUGH THE 19TH AND EARLY 20TH CENTURIES

THE HISTORY OF THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA IN THE 19TH CENTURY WAS MARKED BY PERIODS OF GROWTH, CHALLENGE, AND TRANSFORMATION. THE CIVIL WAR POSED SIGNIFICANT DISRUPTIONS; THE UNIVERSITY CLOSED FOR TWO YEARS DURING THE CONFLICT, AND ITS FACILITIES WERE REPURPOSED AS A CONFEDERATE HOSPITAL. AFTER THE WAR, UVA GRADUALLY RESUMED OPERATIONS, NAVIGATING THE COMPLEX POLITICAL AND SOCIAL DYNAMICS OF RECONSTRUCTION-ERA VIRGINIA.

THROUGHOUT THE LATE 1800S AND EARLY 1900S, THE UNIVERSITY EXPANDED BOTH PHYSICALLY AND ACADEMICALLY. NEW SCHOOLS WERE ESTABLISHED, INCLUDING THE SCHOOL OF ENGINEERING AND APPLIED SCIENCE IN 1836 AND THE SCHOOL OF COMMERCE (LATER THE MCINTIRE SCHOOL OF COMMERCE) IN 1921. THESE ADDITIONS REFLECTED THE UNIVERSITY'S RESPONSIVENESS TO THE EVOLVING ECONOMIC AND INDUSTRIAL LANDSCAPE OF AMERICA.

THE ARCHITECTURAL HERITAGE ALSO GREW WITH NEW BUILDINGS COMPLEMENTING JEFFERSON'S ORIGINAL DESIGN WHILE ADHERING TO THE NEOCLASSICAL STYLE, PRESERVING THE CAMPUS'S HISTORIC AESTHETIC. UVA'S DESIGNATION AS A UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE SITE IN 1987 RECOGNIZED BOTH ITS ARCHITECTURAL SIGNIFICANCE AND ITS ROLE IN ADVANCING HIGHER EDUCATION.

IMPACT OF SOCIAL CHANGE MOVEMENTS

THE 20TH CENTURY WITNESSED SIGNIFICANT SHIFTS IN THE UNIVERSITY'S SOCIAL FABRIC, REFLECTING BROADER SOCIETAL CHANGES. THE HISTORY OF THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA INCLUDES CRITICAL MOMENTS REGARDING RACIAL INTEGRATION AND GENDER EQUALITY. IT WAS NOT UNTIL 1950 THAT THE UNIVERSITY ADMITTED ITS FIRST AFRICAN AMERICAN GRADUATE STUDENT, GREGORY SWANSON, MARKING A PIVOTAL STEP TOWARD DESEGREGATION. FULL INTEGRATION FOLLOWED IN SUBSEQUENT DECADES, ALTHOUGH CHALLENGES PERSISTED.

SIMILARLY, THE ADMISSION OF WOMEN IN 1970 WAS A WATERSHED MOMENT. PRIOR TO THIS, UVA FUNCTIONED AS AN ALL-MALE INSTITUTION FOR MORE THAN 150 YEARS, MIRRORING THE GENDER EXCLUSIVITY COMMON IN HIGHER EDUCATION AT THE TIME. THE INCLUSION OF WOMEN EXPANDED THE UNIVERSITY'S ACADEMIC COMMUNITY AND DIVERSIFIED ITS PERSPECTIVES, ENRICHING THE EDUCATIONAL ENVIRONMENT.

MODERN ERA: RESEARCH, INNOVATION, AND GLOBAL INFLUENCE

TODAY, THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA IS RECOGNIZED AS A LEADING PUBLIC RESEARCH UNIVERSITY WITH A STRONG EMPHASIS ON INTERDISCIPLINARY COLLABORATION AND INNOVATION. ITS HISTORY OF THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA CONTINUES TO EVOLVE AS IT ADAPTS TO THE DEMANDS OF THE 21ST CENTURY. THE INSTITUTION BOASTS OVER 17,000 STUDENTS AND OFFERS A WIDE RANGE OF UNDERGRADUATE, GRADUATE, AND PROFESSIONAL PROGRAMS.

ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE AND RANKINGS

UVA CONSISTENTLY RANKS AMONG THE TOP PUBLIC UNIVERSITIES IN THE UNITED STATES. ITS STRENGTHS IN FIELDS SUCH AS LAW, BUSINESS, MEDICINE, AND ENGINEERING ATTRACT TOP-TIER FACULTY AND STUDENTS WORLDWIDE. THE UNIVERSITY'S COMMITMENT TO RESEARCH IS REFLECTED IN ITS SUBSTANTIAL FUNDING FROM FEDERAL AGENCIES, PRIVATE FOUNDATIONS, AND INDUSTRY PARTNERS.

MOREOVER, UVA'S EMPHASIS ON EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING, LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT, AND COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT ALIGNS WITH JEFFERSON'S ORIGINAL VISION OF AN EDUCATION THAT PREPARES CITIZENS FOR ACTIVE PARTICIPATION IN DEMOCRACY. PROGRAMS SUCH AS THE ECHOLS SCHOLARS AND JEFFERSON SCHOLARS FOSTER ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE AND CIVIC RESPONSIBILITY.

CAMPUS AND CULTURAL LANDSCAPE

THE UNIVERSITY'S CAMPUS REMAINS A BLEND OF HISTORIC PRESERVATION AND MODERN INNOVATION. THE ROTUNDA AND THE LAWN CONTINUE TO SERVE AS ICONIC SYMBOLS, WHILE STATE-OF-THE-ART FACILITIES SUPPORT CUTTING-EDGE RESEARCH AND STUDENT LIFE. UVA'S CULTURAL CONTRIBUTIONS INCLUDE NUMEROUS MUSEUMS, THEATERS, AND STUDENT ORGANIZATIONS THAT ENRICH THE CAMPUS EXPERIENCE.

THE UNIVERSITY ALSO MAINTAINS A STRONG ATHLETIC TRADITION, COMPETING IN NCAA DIVISION I SPORTS AS PART OF THE ATLANTIC COAST CONFERENCE. THIS BLEND OF INTELLECTUAL AND ATHLETIC PURSUITS CONTRIBUTES TO A WELL-ROUNDED COMMUNITY.

CHALLENGES AND CONTROVERSIES

NO COMPREHENSIVE HISTORY OF THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA WOULD OMIT ITS CHALLENGES. THE INSTITUTION HAS FACED CONTROVERSIES RELATED TO RACE, CAMPUS CULTURE, AND GOVERNANCE. DEBATES OVER THE LEGACY OF THOMAS JEFFERSON, PARTICULARLY REGARDING HIS OWNERSHIP OF ENSLAVED PEOPLE, HAVE SPARKED CONVERSATIONS ABOUT RECONCILIATION AND HISTORICAL MEMORY ON CAMPUS.

ADDITIONALLY, UVA HAS WRESTLED WITH INCIDENTS OF INTOLERANCE AND EFFORTS TO PROMOTE INCLUSIVITY AND DIVERSITY. THE UNIVERSITY'S RESPONSES TO THESE CHALLENGES DEMONSTRATE AN ONGOING COMMITMENT TO SELF-EXAMINATION AND PROGRESS, WHICH IS VITAL TO ITS CONTINUED RELEVANCE.

history of the university of virginia: No Ordinary College Brian Steel Wills, 2004 You are making history today, the University of Virginia Extension Division agent Samuel Crockett observed to a gathering of students and faculty on September 15, 1954, in Wise, Virginia. The occasion was the opening convocation of what would become Clinch Valley College of the University of Virginia, and the 109 students assembled, many of whom were Korean War veterans or women, were indeed part of something quite special. People in Southwest Virginia and friends in Charlottesville--not the least being University of Virginia President Colgate W. Darden Jr.--had worked tirelessly to make this day possible. A snowbound discussion at the Colonial Inn in Wise had resulted in the conversion of the local County Poor Farm into the only branch of the University of Virginia. Since those humble beginnings, the College at Wise has flourished, growing from a two-year certificate-granting institution into a four-year baccalaureate-degree-granting college in the late 1960s. In 1999 the college completed a transition from Clinch Valley College to the University of Virginia's College at Wise. Having journeyed over uncertain ground with respect to its student population and its relationship with the University of Virginia, the College at Wise has in recent years boasted its highest historical student enrollments, garnered a national reputation as a public liberal arts college, and still operates as the university's only branch. Published for Wise's fiftieth anniversary in September 2004, Brian Steel Wills's history is essential reading for the college's alumni, faculty and administrators, and for anyone interested in a heroic chapter in the history of public higher education in Virginia.
