## SOCIAL COMMENTARY THROUGH CHARACTERS

## THE INTERSECTION OF FAITH AND POLITICS

ONE OF THE MOST DEFINING ELEMENTS OF SCORSESE'S POLITICAL PERSPECTIVE IS HIS DEEPLY ROOTED CATHOLIC FAITH. THIS DIFFERENCE HIGHLIGHTS A BROADER SPECTRUM WITHIN THE FILM INDUSTRY, WHERE POLITICAL ENGAGEMENT RANGES FROM OVERT ADVOCACY TO SUBTLE THEMATIC EXPLORATION. SCORSESE'S POSITIONING OFFERS A COUNTERPOINT TO MAINSTREAM HOLLYWOOD NARRATIVES, EMPHASIZING COMPLEXITY AND MORAL AMBIGUITY OVER CLEAR-CUT POLITICAL MESSAGING.

## PROS AND CONS OF SCORSESE'S POLITICAL APPROACH
