HOW MANY LANGUAGES TO BE A POLYGLOT: EXPLORING THE MULTILINGUAL THRESHOLD

HOW MANY LANGUAGES TO BE A POLYGLOT IS A QUESTION THAT SPARKS CURIOSITY AMONG LANGUAGE ENTHUSIASTS AND CASUAL LEARNERS ALIKE. IT'S A TERM THAT OFTEN EVOKES IMAGES OF PEOPLE EFFORTLESSLY SWITCHING BETWEEN MULTIPLE LANGUAGES IN CONVERSATIONS OR TRAVELING THE WORLD WITH AN ARSENAL OF TONGUES AT THEIR DISPOSAL. BUT WHAT DOES IT REALLY TAKE TO BE CALLED A POLYGLOT? IS THERE A MAGIC NUMBER OF LANGUAGES YOU MUST MASTER, OR IS IT MORE ABOUT THE PROFICIENCY AND PASSION BEHIND THE EFFORT? LET'S DIVE INTO THE FASCINATING WORLD OF MULTILINGUALISM AND UNCOVER THE NUANCES BEHIND THE LABEL "POLYGLOT."

DEFINING A POLYGLOT: WHAT DOES THE TERM REALLY MEAN?

BEFORE WE GET INTO THE NUMBERS, IT'S IMPORTANT TO UNDERSTAND WHAT BEING A POLYGLOT ENTAILS. THE TERM "POLYGLOT" ORIGINATES FROM THE GREEK WORDS "POLY" (MANY) AND "GLOTTA" (TONGUE OR LANGUAGE), IMPLYING A PERSON WHO KNOWS OR USES SEVERAL LANGUAGES. BUT HOW MANY LANGUAGES ARE CONSIDERED "SEVERAL"?

IN EVERYDAY LANGUAGE, A BILINGUAL PERSON SPEAKS TWO LANGUAGES FLUENTLY, A TRILINGUAL PERSON KNOWS THREE, AND SO ON. BUT THE LABEL POLYGLOT TENDS TO BE RESERVED FOR THOSE WHO CAN COMMUNICATE COMFORTABLY IN MULTIPLE LANGUAGES—OFTEN MORE THAN THREE OR FOUR. SOME LINGUISTS AND LANGUAGE LOVERS SUGGEST THAT SPEAKING FOUR OR MORE LANGUAGES EARNS YOU THE POLYGLOT BADGE, BUT THIS IS BY NO MEANS A STRICT RULE.

THE ROLE OF PROFICIENCY LEVELS IN DEFINING A POLYGLOT

IT'S NOT JUST ABOUT THE QUANTITY OF LANGUAGES SPOKEN BUT THE QUALITY OF YOUR SKILLS IN EACH. MANY PEOPLE MIGHT DABBLE IN SEVERAL LANGUAGES WITHOUT REACHING CONVERSATIONAL OR ADVANCED PROFICIENCY. A TRUE POLYGLOT USUALLY HAS A FUNCTIONAL COMMAND—WHETHER IT'S SPEAKING, READING, OR WRITING—IN MULTIPLE LANGUAGES. THIS MEANS THEY CAN ENGAGE IN MEANINGFUL CONVERSATIONS, UNDERSTAND CULTURAL NUANCES, AND POTENTIALLY SWITCH BETWEEN LANGUAGES WITHOUT SIGNIFICANT HESITATION.

THIS BRINGS UP AN INTERESTING POINT: DOES SOMEONE WHO SPEAKS FOUR LANGUAGES AT A BEGINNER LEVEL QUALIFY AS A POLYGLOT? MOST WOULD ARGUE NO. PROFICIENCY AND ACTIVE USE ARE KEY FACTORS.

HOW MANY LANGUAGES TO BE A POLYGLOT? THE COMMON BENCHMARKS

WHILE THERE'S NO UNIVERSAL CONSENSUS, HERE ARE SOME COMMON BENCHMARKS THAT HELP CLARIFY THE QUESTION OF HOW MANY LANGUAGES TO BE A POLYGLOT:

THREE TO FOUR LANGUAGES: THE STARTING POINT

MANY LANGUAGE EXPERTS CONSIDER FLUENCY IN THREE LANGUAGES AS THE MINIMUM TO BE LABELED A POLYGLOT. WHY THREE? BECAUSE IT GOES BEYOND THE STANDARD BILINGUAL SCENARIO AND REFLECTS A GENUINE INTEREST AND ABILITY TO MANAGE MULTIPLE LINGUISTIC SYSTEMS. FOR EXAMPLE, A NATIVE ENGLISH SPEAKER WHO ALSO SPEAKS FLUENT SPANISH AND FRENCH MIGHT BE CONSIDERED A POLYGLOT.

AT THIS STAGE, LEARNERS OFTEN EXPERIENCE THE JOYS AND CHALLENGES OF JUGGLING DIFFERENT GRAMMATICAL STRUCTURES, VOCABULARIES, AND CULTURAL CONTEXTS. IT'S BOTH REWARDING AND DEMANDING, SHOWCASING THE MENTAL AGILITY OF THE LANGUAGE LEARNER.

FIVE OR MORE LANGUAGES: THE TRUE POLYGLOTS

FOR THOSE WHO REACH FIVE OR MORE LANGUAGES, THE TERM “HYPERPOLYGLOT” SOMETIMES COMES INTO PLAY. HYPERPOLYGLOTS ARE INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE MASTERED SIX, SEVEN, OR EVEN DOZENS OF LANGUAGES TO VARYING DEGREES OF PROFICIENCY. THEY OFTEN HAVE A DEEP PASSION FOR LANGUAGES AND USE SPECIFIC LEARNING TECHNIQUES TO ACQUIRE AND MAINTAIN MULTIPLE LANGUAGES.

THESE LANGUAGE LOVERS NOT ONLY KNOW HOW MANY LANGUAGES TO BE A POLYGLOT BUT ALSO PUSH BOUNDARIES WITH THEIR LINGUISTIC ABILITIES, SOMETIMES LEARNING LANGUAGES FROM DIVERSE FAMILIES LIKE ROMANCE, SLAVIC, SINO-TIBETAN, AND SEMITIC.

FACTORS THAT INFLUENCE HOW MANY LANGUAGES ONE CAN LEARN

KNOWING HOW MANY LANGUAGES TO BE A POLYGLOT IS JUST THE STARTING POINT. THE JOURNEY TO BECOMING ONE DEPENDS ON SEVERAL KEY FACTORS THAT CAN EITHER ACCELERATE OR SLOW DOWN PROGRESS.

MOTIVATION AND PURPOSE

THE STRONGEST DRIVER BEHIND LEARNING MULTIPLE LANGUAGES IS MOTIVATION. WHETHER IT’S CULTURAL INTEREST, CAREER GOALS, TRAVEL, OR PERSONAL CHALLENGE, HAVING A CLEAR REASON TO LEARN A LANGUAGE HELPS MAINTAIN MOMENTUM ACROSS MULTIPLE TONGUES. POLYGLOTS OFTEN HAVE A GENUINE LOVE FOR LANGUAGES, WHICH KEEPS THEIR ENTHUSIASM ALIVE EVEN WHEN FACING DIFFICULT GRAMMAR OR PRONUNCIATION HURDLES.

LEARNING ENVIRONMENT AND EXPOSURE

IMMERSION AND CONSISTENT EXPOSURE TO THE TARGET LANGUAGES MAKE A HUGE DIFFERENCE. LIVING IN MULTILINGUAL ENVIRONMENTS OR HAVING ACCESS TO NATIVE SPEAKERS FACILITATES QUICKER AND DEEPER LEARNING. POLYGLOTS OFTEN CREATE LANGUAGE-RICH ENVIRONMENTS BY CONSUMING MEDIA, READING BOOKS, AND PRACTICING CONVERSATION REGULARLY.

LANGUAGE SIMILARITY AND FAMILY TIES

LANGUAGES RELATED BY FAMILY TEND TO BE EASIER TO LEARN IN CLUSTERS. FOR EXAMPLE, ROMANCE LANGUAGES LIKE SPANISH, ITALIAN, AND PORTUGUESE SHARE MANY SIMILARITIES. THIS LINGUISTIC OVERLAP CAN MAKE IT MORE FEASIBLE TO ACQUIRE SEVERAL LANGUAGES WITHIN THE SAME FAMILY, THEREBY INCREASING THE NUMBER OF LANGUAGES ONE CAN REALISTICALLY LEARN.

TIME AND COGNITIVE FACTORS

LEARNING MULTIPLE LANGUAGES REQUIRES TIME AND MENTAL ENERGY. POLYGLOTS OFTEN DEDICATE CONSISTENT DAILY PRACTICE, SOMETIMES BALANCING LEARNING WITH OTHER RESPONSIBILITIES. COGNITIVE FACTORS SUCH AS MEMORY, PATTERN RECOGNITION, AND MULTITASKING SKILLS ALSO PLAY A ROLE IN HOW MANY LANGUAGES A PERSON CAN EFFECTIVELY HANDLE.

COMMON MYTHS ABOUT POLYGLOTS AND LANGUAGE LEARNING

WHEN EXPLORING HOW MANY LANGUAGES TO BE A POLYGLOT, IT’S EASY TO FALL INTO SOME MISCONCEPTIONS. LET’S DEBUNK

A FEW:

- **MYTH 1: POLYGLOTS LEARN LANGUAGES OVERNIGHT**

IN REALITY, ACQUIRING PROFICIENCY IN MULTIPLE LANGUAGES TAKES TIME, EFFORT, AND PATIENCE. THERE ARE NO SHORTCUTS, ONLY STRATEGIES.

- **MYTH 2: YOU MUST BE FLUENT IN EVERY LANGUAGE**

FLUENCY CAN VARY. MANY POLYGLOTS MAINTAIN DIFFERENT LEVELS OF PROFICIENCY DEPENDING ON THEIR NEEDS AND INTERESTS.

- **MYTH 3: ONLY GIFTED PEOPLE CAN BE POLYGLOTS**

LANGUAGE LEARNING IS A SKILL ANYONE CAN DEVELOP WITH PRACTICE AND DEDICATION, NOT JUST AN INNATE TALENT.

- **MYTH 4: MORE LANGUAGES MEAN BETTER INTELLIGENCE**

WHILE MULTILINGUALISM CAN ENHANCE COGNITIVE FUNCTIONS, THE NUMBER OF LANGUAGES YOU SPEAK DOESN'T AUTOMATICALLY EQUATE TO INTELLIGENCE.

TIPS FOR ASPIRING POLYGLOTS: HOW TO MANAGE MULTIPLE LANGUAGES

IF YOU'RE INSPIRED BY THE IDEA OF BECOMING A POLYGLOT, HERE ARE SOME PRACTICAL TIPS TO HELP YOU ON YOUR JOURNEY:

1. **SET REALISTIC GOALS:** FOCUS ON ONE LANGUAGE AT A TIME OR BALANCE A COUPLE OF LANGUAGES RATHER THAN OVERWHELMING YOURSELF.
2. **USE DIVERSE RESOURCES:** COMBINE APPS, PODCASTS, BOOKS, AND CONVERSATION PARTNERS TO KEEP LEARNING ENGAGING.
3. **PRACTICE REGULARLY:** CONSISTENCY BEATS INTENSITY. EVEN 15-20 MINUTES A DAY CAN MAKE A BIG DIFFERENCE.
4. **CONNECT WITH COMMUNITIES:** JOIN LANGUAGE MEETUPS OR ONLINE FORUMS TO PRACTICE AND STAY MOTIVATED.
5. **EMBRACE MISTAKES:** LANGUAGE LEARNING INVOLVES TRIAL AND ERROR. DON'T FEAR MAKING MISTAKES—THEY'RE PART OF THE PROCESS.
6. **REVIEW AND MAINTAIN:** LANGUAGES CAN FADE WITHOUT USE, SO REGULARLY REVISIT THOSE YOU'VE LEARNED TO KEEP SKILLS SHARP.

WHY PASSION MATTERS MORE THAN NUMBERS

ULTIMATELY, THE ANSWER TO HOW MANY LANGUAGES TO BE A POLYGLOT DEPENDS ON WHAT DRIVES YOU. SOME PEOPLE ARE CONTENT MASTERING A HANDFUL OF LANGUAGES DEEPLY, WHILE OTHERS DELIGHT IN DABBLING IN DOZENS. THE KEY IS TO ENJOY THE PROCESS AND FEEL CONNECTED TO THE LANGUAGES YOU CHOOSE. PASSION FUELS PERSISTENCE, AND PERSISTENCE LEADS TO PROGRESS.

FOR MANY, BEING A POLYGLOT IS LESS ABOUT HITTING A MAGICAL NUMBER AND MORE ABOUT EMBRACING THE JOURNEY OF LEARNING NEW WAYS TO COMMUNICATE WITH THE WORLD. SO WHETHER YOU SPEAK THREE, FIVE, OR FIFTEEN LANGUAGES, IF YOU LOVE WHAT YOU'RE DOING, YOU'RE ALREADY PART OF THE POLYGLOT COMMUNITY.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

HOW MANY LANGUAGES DOES ONE NEED TO SPEAK TO BE CONSIDERED A POLYGLOT?

GENERALLY, A PERSON IS CONSIDERED A POLYGLOT IF THEY CAN SPEAK THREE OR MORE LANGUAGES PROFICIENTLY.

IS THERE A MINIMUM NUMBER OF LANGUAGES REQUIRED TO BE CALLED A POLYGLOT?

YES, THE MINIMUM NUMBER IS TYPICALLY THREE LANGUAGES, INCLUDING THE PERSON'S NATIVE LANGUAGE.

CAN SOMEONE BE A POLYGLOT IF THEY ONLY SPEAK TWO LANGUAGES FLUENTLY?

NO, SPEAKING TWO LANGUAGES FLUENTLY MAKES SOMEONE BILINGUAL, WHILE A POLYGLOT SPEAKS THREE OR MORE LANGUAGES.

ARE THERE DIFFERENT LEVELS OF POLYGLOTISM BASED ON THE NUMBER OF LANGUAGES SPOKEN?

YES, TERMS LIKE 'TRILINGUAL' (3 LANGUAGES), 'QUADRILINGUAL' (4 LANGUAGES), AND 'HYPERPOLYGLOT' (USUALLY 6 OR MORE) DESCRIBE DIFFERENT LEVELS.

DOES THE PROFICIENCY LEVEL IN EACH LANGUAGE AFFECT BEING CLASSIFIED AS A POLYGLOT?

YES, TO BE CONSIDERED A POLYGLOT, ONE SHOULD HAVE CONVERSATIONAL OR HIGHER PROFICIENCY IN THE LANGUAGES THEY SPEAK.

CAN PASSIVE KNOWLEDGE OF LANGUAGES COUNT TOWARDS BEING A POLYGLOT?

PASSIVE KNOWLEDGE LIKE UNDERSTANDING BUT NOT SPEAKING USUALLY DOESN'T COUNT; ACTIVE SPEAKING SKILLS ARE GENERALLY REQUIRED.

IS IT MORE IMPORTANT TO KNOW MANY LANGUAGES OR TO MASTER A FEW TO BE A POLYGLOT?

BEING A POLYGLOT EMPHASIZES KNOWING MULTIPLE LANGUAGES, BUT PROFICIENCY AND PRACTICAL ABILITY ARE ALSO IMPORTANT FOR THE CLASSIFICATION.

HOW COMMON IS IT FOR POLYGLOTS TO SPEAK MORE THAN FIVE LANGUAGES?

WHILE MANY POLYGLOTS SPEAK 3-5 LANGUAGES, SOME HIGHLY DEDICATED INDIVIDUALS, CALLED HYPERPOLYGLOTS, SPEAK SIX OR MORE LANGUAGES FLUENTLY.

CAN CHILDREN BE POLYGLOTS, AND IF SO, HOW MANY LANGUAGES CAN THEY LEARN?

YES, CHILDREN CAN BE POLYGLOTS AND OFTEN LEARN MULTIPLE LANGUAGES SIMULTANEOUSLY, SOMETIMES THREE OR MORE, ESPECIALLY IN MULTILINGUAL ENVIRONMENTS.

ADDITIONAL RESOURCES

HOW MANY LANGUAGES TO BE A POLYGLOT: DEFINING THE THRESHOLD AND EXPLORING LINGUISTIC MASTERY

HOW MANY LANGUAGES TO BE A POLYGLOT IS A QUESTION THAT HAS INTRIGUED LANGUAGE ENTHUSIASTS, LINGUISTS, AND CASUAL LEARNERS ALIKE. THE TERM "POLYGLOT" CONJURES IMAGES OF INDIVIDUALS EFFORTLESSLY SWITCHING BETWEEN SEVERAL TONGUES, OFTEN WITH IMPRESSIVE FLUENCY. YET, DESPITE THE ROMANTICIZED NOTION, THERE IS NO UNIVERSALLY AGREED-UPON STANDARD FOR HOW MANY LANGUAGES ONE MUST KNOW TO EARN THE TITLE OF POLYGLOT. THIS ARTICLE DELVES INTO THE ORIGINS OF THE TERM, THE VARYING DEFINITIONS, AND THE PRACTICAL CONSIDERATIONS SURROUNDING LINGUISTIC PROFICIENCY AND THE POLYGLOT IDENTITY.

THE ORIGIN AND DEFINITION OF POLYGLOT

THE WORD "POLYGLOT" DERIVES FROM THE GREEK ROOTS *POLY-* MEANING "MANY" AND *GLŶTTA* MEANING "TONGUE" OR "LANGUAGE." HISTORICALLY, IT REFERRED TO TEXTS WRITTEN IN MULTIPLE LANGUAGES OR INDIVIDUALS CAPABLE OF SPEAKING MULTIPLE LANGUAGES. IN MODERN USAGE, A POLYGLOT IS SOMEONE PROFICIENT IN SEVERAL LANGUAGES, BUT THE EXACT NUMBER IS SUBJECTIVE AND CONTEXT-DEPENDENT.

LINGUISTIC COMMUNITIES AND SCHOLARS OFTEN DIFFER IN THEIR CRITERIA. SOME CLAIM THAT SPEAKING THREE LANGUAGES QUALIFIES ONE AS A POLYGLOT, WHEREAS OTHERS ARGUE THAT THE THRESHOLD IS SIGNIFICANTLY HIGHER, STARTING AT FIVE OR EVEN SIX LANGUAGES. THE AMBIGUITY STEMS FROM THE COMPLEXITY OF LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY ITSELF, WHICH INVOLVES NOT ONLY VOCABULARY ACQUISITION BUT ALSO GRAMMAR, PRONUNCIATION, COMPREHENSION, AND CULTURAL NUANCES.

HOW MANY LANGUAGES TO BE A POLYGLOT?

THE CORE QUESTION—HOW MANY LANGUAGES TO BE A POLYGLOT—LACKS A DEFINITIVE NUMERIC ANSWER. HOWEVER, EXAMINING DIFFERENT PERSPECTIVES CAN SHED LIGHT ON COMMON INTERPRETATIONS AND EXPECTATIONS.

TRILINGUALISM VS. POLYGLOTTERY

TRILINGUALISM, THE ABILITY TO SPEAK THREE LANGUAGES, IS OFTEN CONSIDERED THE BASIC ENTRY POINT INTO MULTILINGUAL COMPETENCE. YET, MANY LINGUISTS RESERVE THE LABEL "POLYGLOT" FOR INDIVIDUALS WHO SURPASS TRILINGUALISM, SUGGESTING A MINIMUM OF FOUR OR FIVE LANGUAGES. THE DISTINCTION LIES IN THE BREADTH OF LINGUISTIC KNOWLEDGE AND THE COGNITIVE FLEXIBILITY REQUIRED TO MANAGE MULTIPLE LANGUAGE SYSTEMS.

COMMON THRESHOLDS IN LANGUAGE COMMUNITIES

- **THREE LANGUAGES:** SOME PURISTS ARGUE THAT KNOWING THREE LANGUAGES, ESPECIALLY IF LEARNED TO A CONVERSATIONAL LEVEL, IS ENOUGH TO BE CALLED A POLYGLOT. THIS VIEW EMPHASIZES FUNCTIONAL MULTILINGUALISM RATHER THAN MASTERY.
- **FIVE LANGUAGES:** THE MOST WIDELY ACCEPTED BENCHMARK AMONG LANGUAGE ENTHUSIASTS AND ACADEMIC CIRCLES IS FIVE LANGUAGES. AT THIS LEVEL, INDIVIDUALS TYPICALLY DEMONSTRATE ADVANCED COMPREHENSION AND THE ABILITY TO SWITCH CONTEXTS SEAMLESSLY.
- **SIX OR MORE LANGUAGES:** FOR A MORE ELITE CLASSIFICATION, POLYGLOTS WHO COMMAND SIX OR MORE LANGUAGES OFTEN GAIN RECOGNITION FOR THEIR EXCEPTIONAL LINGUISTIC APTITUDE. THIS BRACKET OVERLAPS WITH THE TERM "HYPERPOLYGLOT," USED TO DESCRIBE THOSE WHO LEARN AN EXTRAORDINARY NUMBER OF LANGUAGES.

THE ROLE OF PROFICIENCY IN DEFINING A POLYGLOT

QUANTITY ALONE DOES NOT DEFINE POLYGLOTTERY. THE LEVEL OF PROFICIENCY IN EACH LANGUAGE MATTERS SIGNIFICANTLY. FOR INSTANCE, A PERSON WHO SPEAKS FIVE LANGUAGES AT A RUDIMENTARY LEVEL MAY NOT BE CONSIDERED A POLYGLOT BY SOME STANDARDS, WHEREAS ANOTHER INDIVIDUAL FLUENT IN THREE LANGUAGES AND CONVERSATIONAL IN TWO OTHERS MIGHT

BE.

PROFICIENCY IS OFTEN CATEGORIZED USING FRAMEWORKS LIKE THE COMMON EUROPEAN FRAMEWORK OF REFERENCE FOR LANGUAGES (CEFR), WHICH RANGES FROM A1 (BEGINNER) TO C2 (MASTERY). MANY POLYGLOTS AIM FOR AT LEAST A B2 OR C1 LEVEL IN MULTIPLE LANGUAGES, BALANCING CONVERSATIONAL FLUENCY WITH CULTURAL UNDERSTANDING.

WHY DOES THE NUMBER OF LANGUAGES MATTER?

UNDERSTANDING HOW MANY LANGUAGES TO BE A POLYGLOT IS NOT MERELY AN ACADEMIC EXERCISE; IT HAS PRACTICAL IMPLICATIONS FOR IDENTITY, MOTIVATION, AND LEARNING STRATEGIES.

IDENTITY AND SOCIAL RECOGNITION

BEING LABELED A POLYGLOT CAN INFLUENCE PERSONAL IDENTITY AND SOCIAL PERCEPTION. IN PROFESSIONAL SETTINGS, MULTILINGUALISM IS A VALUABLE ASSET, BUT CLAIMING POLYGLOTTERY ADDS A LAYER OF PRESTIGE. CLARITY ABOUT THE NUMBER OF LANGUAGES AND PROFICIENCY LEVELS HELPS AVOID MISUNDERSTANDINGS OR INFLATED CLAIMS.

LEARNING COMMITMENT AND COGNITIVE LOAD

THE COGNITIVE EFFORT REQUIRED TO LEARN AND MAINTAIN MULTIPLE LANGUAGES GROWS WITH EACH ADDITIONAL LANGUAGE. SETTING A REALISTIC TARGET FOR HOW MANY LANGUAGES TO BE A POLYGLOT HELPS LEARNERS ALLOCATE TIME AND RESOURCES EFFECTIVELY. RESEARCH IN PSYCHOLINGUISTICS SUGGESTS THAT MANAGING MORE THAN FIVE LANGUAGES DEMANDS SOPHISTICATED MENTAL ORGANIZATION AND CONSISTENT PRACTICE.

LANGUAGE MAINTENANCE CHALLENGES

POLYGLOTS MUST BALANCE ACQUIRING NEW LANGUAGES AND MAINTAINING EXISTING ONES. LANGUAGE ATTRITION IS COMMON, ESPECIALLY WHEN LANGUAGES ARE USED INFREQUENTLY. THIS DYNAMIC COMPLICATES THE QUESTION OF HOW MANY LANGUAGES TO BE A POLYGLOT, AS SOME MAY REACH A HIGH NUMBER TEMPORARILY BUT LOSE PROFICIENCY WITHOUT ONGOING ENGAGEMENT.

POLYGLOTISM IN PRACTICE: EXAMPLES AND PERSPECTIVES

SEVERAL RENOWNED POLYGLOTS PROVIDE INSIGHT INTO THE PRACTICAL REALITIES OF MASTERING MULTIPLE LANGUAGES.

IN AN INCREASINGLY GLOBALIZED WORLD, THE ALLURE OF POLYGLOTISM CONTINUES TO INSPIRE LEARNERS FROM ALL WALKS OF LIFE. RATHER THAN FIXATING ON A NUMERIC THRESHOLD, EMBRACING THE PROCESS OF LINGUISTIC EXPLORATION MAY BE THE MOST AUTHENTIC MEASURE OF A TRUE POLYGLOT.

The key of competitiveness is knowledge, because of the necessity of reactivity, flexibility, agility and innovation capacities. Knowledge is difficult to measure itself but what is visible, this is the way of improving products, technologies and enterprise organizations. During the last four years, based on the experience of most of the best experts around the World, CIRP (The International Academy for Production Engineering) has decided to prepare and structure a Network of Excellence (NoE) proposal.
