ORMOND BEACH HURRICANE HISTORY: A LOOK BACK AT NATURE'S FURY ON FLORIDA'S COAST

ORMOND BEACH HURRICANE HISTORY IS A FASCINATING AND SOBERING TOPIC THAT REVEALS HOW THIS CHARMING COASTAL CITY HAS REPEATEDLY FACED THE WRATH OF TROPICAL STORMS AND HURRICANES OVER THE DECADES. THE GEOGRAPHIC VULNERABILITY OF ORMOND BEACH

ORMOND BEACH'S LOCATION MAKES IT PARTICULARLY SUSCEPTIBLE TO HURRICANES AND TROPICAL STORMS. SITUATED JUST NORTH OF DAYTONA BEACH, IT LIES DIRECTLY ALONG THE ATLANTIC HURRICANE CORRIDOR. WARM OCEAN WATERS OFF THE COAST FREQUENTLY FUEL STORMS THAT DEVELOP INTO HURRICANES, WHICH THEN OFTEN MAKE LANDFALL ALONG FLORIDA'S EASTERN SHORE. THIS GEOGRAPHIC REALITY HAS MEANT THAT ORMOND BEACH IS NO STRANGER TO EXTREME WEATHER EVENTS.

THE CITY'S PROXIMITY TO THE ATLANTIC OCEAN MEANS THAT STORM SURGES, HEAVY RAINFALL, AND DESTRUCTIVE WINDS ARE COMMON THREATS DURING HURRICANE SEASON. OVER TIME, THIS VULNERABILITY HAS INFLUENCED LOCAL BUILDING CODES, EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT POLICIES, AND PUBLIC AWARENESS CAMPAIGNS FOCUSED ON MITIGATING HURRICANE DAMAGE.

HISTORICAL HURRICANES IMPACTING ORMOND BEACH

LOOKING BACK THROUGH THE ANNALS OF ORMOND BEACH HURRICANE HISTORY, SEVERAL NOTABLE STORMS STAND OUT DUE TO THEIR INTENSITY AND THE DAMAGE THEY CAUSED.

- **THE 1926 MIAMI HURRICANE:** ALTHOUGH PRIMARILY DEVASTATING MIAMI, THIS POWERFUL CATEGORY 4 HURRICANE MADE ITS PRESENCE FELT UP THE COAST. ORMOND BEACH EXPERIENCED SEVERE FLOODING AND WIND DAMAGE, MARKING ONE OF THE EARLIEST RECORDED MAJOR HURRICANES TO IMPACT THE AREA SIGNIFICANTLY.
- **HURRICANE DONNA (1960):** ONE OF THE MOST INFAMOUS STORMS TO HIT FLORIDA, HURRICANE DONNA SWEEPED THROUGH ORMOND BEACH WITH SUSTAINED WINDS OVER 100 MPH. THE STORM CAUSED WIDESPREAD DESTRUCTION, INCLUDING DOWNED TREES, DAMAGED HOMES, AND SIGNIFICANT BEACH EROSION.
- **HURRICANE FLOYD (1999):** WHILE FLOYD WAS A CATEGORY 2 HURRICANE AT LANDFALL, IT BROUGHT TORRENTIAL RAINS AND FLOODING TO ORMOND BEACH AND SURROUNDING AREAS. FLOODWATERS IMPACTED HOMES AND INFRASTRUCTURE, HIGHLIGHTING THE NEED FOR IMPROVED DRAINAGE SYSTEMS IN THE CITY.
- **HURRICANE MATTHEW (2016):** THIS CATEGORY 3 HURRICANE SKIRTED JUST OFFSHORE BUT STILL DELIVERED POWERFUL WINDS AND HEAVY RAINFALL TO ORMOND BEACH. IT CAUSED COASTAL FLOODING AND POWER OUTAGES, REMINDING RESIDENTS THAT EVEN STORMS PASSING NEARBY CAN HAVE SERIOUS EFFECTS.

THESE EVENTS ARE JUST A FEW EXAMPLES DEMONSTRATING HOW ORMOND BEACH HAS ENDURED AND ADAPTED THROUGH DECADES OF HURRICANE ACTIVITY.

THE EVOLUTION OF HURRICANE PREPAREDNESS IN ORMOND BEACH

ORMOND BEACH'S HISTORY WITH HURRICANES HAS TAUGHT VALUABLE LESSONS ABOUT PREPARATION, RESPONSE, AND RECOVERY. OVER THE YEARS, LOCAL AUTHORITIES AND RESIDENTS HAVE BECOME INCREASINGLY PROACTIVE IN MITIGATING HURRICANE RISKS.

BUILDING CODES AND INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS

AFTER EXPERIENCING REPEATED DAMAGE FROM STORMS, ORMOND BEACH IMPLEMENTED STRICTER BUILDING CODES DESIGNED TO WITHSTAND HIGH WINDS AND FLOODING. NEW CONSTRUCTIONS ARE OFTEN REQUIRED TO ELEVATE HOMES AND REINFORCE STRUCTURES TO REDUCE VULNERABILITY. ADDITIONALLY, SEAWALLS AND DUNE RESTORATION PROJECTS HAVE BEEN INITIATED TO PROTECT THE COASTLINE FROM STORM SURGES AND EROSION.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND COMMUNITY AWARENESS

THE CITY'S EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT TEAM WORKS YEAR-ROUND TO EDUCATE RESIDENTS ABOUT HURRICANE PREPAREDNESS. THIS INCLUDES ENCOURAGING EARLY EVACUATION, STOCKING EMERGENCY SUPPLIES, AND CREATING FAMILY EMERGENCY PLANS. PUBLIC AWARENESS CAMPAIGNS OFTEN RAMP UP BEFORE HURRICANE SEASON, EMPHASIZING THE IMPORTANCE OF STAYING INFORMED THROUGH OFFICIAL WEATHER ALERTS.

EVACUATION ROUTES AND SHELTERS

GIVEN ORMOND BEACH'S LOCATION, HAVING CLEAR EVACUATION ROUTES IS CRITICAL. THE CITY HAS DESIGNATED MULTIPLE EVACUATION CORRIDORS THAT HELP RESIDENTS MOVE INLAND QUICKLY WHEN A HURRICANE THREATENS. COMMUNITY SHELTERS ARE ALSO MAINTAINED AND EQUIPPED TO PROVIDE SAFE REFUGE FOR THOSE WITHOUT SECURE HOMES DURING A STORM.

THE IMPACT OF HURRICANES ON ORMOND BEACH'S ENVIRONMENT

BEYOND IMMEDIATE PHYSICAL DAMAGE, HURRICANES HAVE LONG-TERM EFFECTS ON ORMOND BEACH'S NATURAL ENVIRONMENT. THE AREA'S BEACHES, WETLANDS, AND MARINE ECOSYSTEMS CAN BE DEEPLY ALTERED BY STORM ACTIVITY.

BEACH EROSION AND RESTORATION EFFORTS

STORM SURGES AND POWERFUL WAVES DURING HURRICANES OFTEN LEAD TO SIGNIFICANT BEACH EROSION IN ORMOND BEACH. THIS NOT ONLY AFFECTS LOCAL TOURISM BUT ALSO COMPROMISES NATURAL BARRIERS THAT PROTECT INLAND AREAS FROM FLOODING. TO COMBAT THIS, THE CITY COLLABORATES WITH ENVIRONMENTAL AGENCIES ON BEACH NOURISHMENT PROJECTS, WHICH INVOLVE REPLENISHING SAND AND RESTORING DUNES TO THEIR NATURAL STATE.

IMPACT ON COASTAL WILDLIFE

HURRICANES CAN DISRUPT HABITATS FOR COASTAL WILDLIFE, INCLUDING SEA TURTLES, SHOREBIRDS, AND MARINE SPECIES. NESTING SITES MAY BE DESTROYED, AND WATER QUALITY CAN DECLINE DUE TO RUNOFF AND DEBRIS. CONSERVATION GROUPS IN THE REGION WORK DILIGENTLY TO MONITOR THESE IMPACTS AND SUPPORT RECOVERY PROGRAMS TO HELP PRESERVE ORMOND BEACH'S RICH BIODIVERSITY.

LEARNING FROM THE PAST: HOW ORMOND BEACH PREPARES FOR FUTURE HURRICANES

THE LESSONS LEARNED FROM ORMOND BEACH'S HURRICANE HISTORY CONTINUE TO SHAPE ITS APPROACH TO FUTURE STORMS. RESIDENTS, BUSINESSES, AND GOVERNMENT AGENCIES COLLABORATE TO STRENGTHEN COMMUNITY RESILIENCE.

TECHNOLOGICAL ADVANCEMENTS IN STORM TRACKING AND COMMUNICATION

MODERN METEOROLOGICAL TECHNOLOGY ALLOWS FOR MORE ACCURATE AND TIMELY HURRICANE FORECASTING. ORMOND BEACH BENEFITS FROM SOPHISTICATED RADAR SYSTEMS AND SATELLITE DATA THAT PROVIDE EARLY WARNINGS. THIS ALLOWS RESIDENTS TO PREPARE WELL AHEAD OF TIME, REDUCING THE RISK OF INJURY AND PROPERTY LOSS.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT AND VOLUNTEER PROGRAMS

LOCAL VOLUNTEER ORGANIZATIONS PLAY A CRITICAL ROLE DURING HURRICANE SEASON. THEY ASSIST WITH EVACUATION EFFORTS, PROVIDE AID DURING RECOVERY, AND HELP DISSEMINATE IMPORTANT INFORMATION. COMMUNITY-DRIVEN INITIATIVES HAVE GROWN STRONGER, FOSTERING A CULTURE OF PREPAREDNESS AND MUTUAL SUPPORT.

INSURANCE AND FINANCIAL PREPAREDNESS

UNDERSTANDING THE FINANCIAL RISKS ASSOCIATED WITH HURRICANES, MANY ORMOND BEACH HOMEOWNERS INVEST IN COMPREHENSIVE INSURANCE COVERAGE TAILORED TO HURRICANE DAMAGE. ADDITIONALLY, THERE ARE RESOURCES AVAILABLE TO HELP RESIDENTS RECOVER FINANCIALLY IN THE AFTERMATH OF A STORM, MAKING RECOVERY SMOOTHER AND LESS STRESSFUL.

REFLECTING ON ORMOND BEACH'S RESILIENCE

THE RICH TAPESTRY OF ORMOND BEACH HURRICANE HISTORY TELLS A STORY OF CHALLENGES MET WITH DETERMINATION. EACH HURRICANE THAT HAS PASSED THROUGH THE AREA HAS LEFT ITS MARK, BUT ALSO SERVED AS A CATALYST FOR IMPROVEMENT. FROM ENHANCING INFRASTRUCTURE AND EMERGENCY PROTOCOLS TO FOSTERING COMMUNITY SPIRIT AND ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP, ORMOND BEACH EXEMPLIFIES HOW A COASTAL CITY CAN GROW STRONGER DESPITE NATURE'S UNPREDICTABILITY.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT IS THE HISTORY OF HURRICANES IMPACTING ORMOND BEACH, FLORIDA?

ORMOND BEACH, FLORIDA, HAS EXPERIENCED SEVERAL HURRICANES OVER THE YEARS, WITH NOTABLE IMPACTS FROM STORMS SUCH AS HURRICANE DORA IN 1964 AND HURRICANE MATTHEW IN 2016. THE CITY IS VULNERABLE DUE TO ITS COASTAL LOCATION ALONG THE ATLANTIC OCEAN.

WHICH HURRICANES HAVE CAUSED THE MOST DAMAGE IN ORMOND BEACH?

HURRICANE DORA IN 1964 AND HURRICANE MATTHEW IN 2016 ARE AMONG THE MOST DAMAGING HURRICANES TO HAVE IMPACTED ORMOND BEACH. DORA CAUSED SIGNIFICANT WIND AND FLOOD DAMAGE, WHILE MATTHEW BROUGHT HEAVY RAINFALL AND STORM SURGE.

HOW OFTEN DO HURRICANES HIT ORMOND BEACH?

HURRICANES DIRECTLY HITTING ORMOND BEACH ARE RELATIVELY INFREQUENT, BUT THE AREA IS AFFECTED BY TROPICAL STORMS AND HURRICANES APPROXIMATELY EVERY 5 TO 10 YEARS, WITH VARYING DEGREES OF IMPACT DEPENDING ON THE STORM'S INTENSITY AND PATH.

WHAT MEASURES HAS ORMOND BEACH TAKEN TO PREPARE FOR HURRICANES?

ORMOND BEACH HAS IMPLEMENTED SEVERAL PREPAREDNESS MEASURES INCLUDING EVACUATION PLANS, STORM SURGE BARRIERS, PUBLIC EDUCATION PROGRAMS, AND INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS TO MITIGATE HURRICANE DAMAGE AND ENSURE RESIDENT SAFETY.

HAS CLIMATE CHANGE AFFECTED THE HURRICANE HISTORY OF ORMOND BEACH?

CLIMATE CHANGE IS BELIEVED TO INCREASE THE INTENSITY AND FREQUENCY OF HURRICANES IN THE ATLANTIC, WHICH COULD LEAD TO MORE SEVERE STORMS IMPACTING ORMOND BEACH IN THE FUTURE. RISING SEA LEVELS ALSO INCREASE THE RISK OF FLOODING FROM STORM SURGES.

HISTORICAL CONTEXT OF HURRICANES IN ORMOND BEACH

ORMOND BEACH, PART OF VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA, LIES IN A REGION FREQUENTLY VULNERABLE TO ATLANTIC HURRICANES DUE TO ITS GEOGRAPHICAL POSITION ALONG THE SOUTHEASTERN UNITED STATES COASTLINE. HISTORICALLY, THE AREA HAS BEEN AFFECTED BY SEVERAL HURRICANES THAT HAVE RANGED IN STRENGTH AND IMPACT, FROM TROPICAL STORMS CAUSING MINOR FLOODING TO POWERFUL CATEGORY 3 AND ABOVE HURRICANES RESULTING IN EXTENSIVE DAMAGE.

THE HISTORY OF STORMS IMPACTING ORMOND BEACH IS INTRINSICALLY LINKED TO BROADER HURRICANE PATTERNS AFFECTING FLORIDA'S ATLANTIC COAST. THESE PATTERNS ARE INFLUENCED BY OCEANIC AND ATMOSPHERIC CONDITIONS, INCLUDING SEA SURFACE TEMPERATURES AND PREVAILING WIND CURRENTS, WHICH CAN AMPLIFY OR MITIGATE HURRICANE DEVELOPMENT AND TRAJECTORIES.

NOTABLE HURRICANES IMPACTING ORMOND BEACH

SEVERAL HURRICANES STAND OUT IN ORMOND BEACH'S METEOROLOGICAL RECORD DUE TO THEIR INTENSITY AND LASTING EFFECTS:

- **HURRICANE DORA (1964):** ONE OF THE EARLIEST MAJOR HURRICANES TO CAUSE SIGNIFICANT DISRUPTION IN ORMOND BEACH. DORA MADE LANDFALL AS A CATEGORY 2 HURRICANE, BRINGING HEAVY RAINS AND SUSTAINED WINDS THAT DAMAGED INFRASTRUCTURE AND HOMES NEAR THE COASTLINE.
- **HURRICANE JEANNE (2004):** JEANNE PASSED NEAR ORMOND BEACH AS A CATEGORY 3 HURRICANE, CAUSING WIDESPREAD FLOODING AND WIND DAMAGE. THE STORM'S SLOW MOVEMENT EXACERBATED FLOODING, PARTICULARLY IN LOW-LYING AREAS AND ALONG THE TOMOKA RIVER BASIN.
- **HURRICANE MATTHEW (2016):** THOUGH MATTHEW DID NOT MAKE DIRECT LANDFALL IN ORMOND BEACH, ITS PROXIMITY DELIVERED SUBSTANTIAL STORM SURGE AND HEAVY RAINFALL, TESTING THE CITY'S EMERGENCY RESPONSE AND FLOOD CONTROL SYSTEMS.
- **HURRICANE IRMA (2017):** IRMA'S BROAD IMPACT EXTENDED TO ORMOND BEACH WITH HIGH WINDS AND PROLONGED RAINFALL, LEADING TO POWER OUTAGES AND STRUCTURAL DAMAGES, DESPITE THE STORM MAKING LANDFALL FURTHER SOUTH.

EACH OF THESE EVENTS CONTRIBUTED TO REFINING LOCAL HURRICANE PREPAREDNESS AND INFRASTRUCTURE RESILIENCE, HIGHLIGHTING THE EVOLVING NATURE OF ORMOND BEACH'S APPROACH TO STORM THREATS.

IMPACT ANALYSIS: STORM SURGE, WIND DAMAGE, AND FLOODING

UNDERSTANDING THE MULTIFACETED IMPACTS OF HURRICANES ON ORMOND BEACH REQUIRES EXAMINING THE PRIMARY DESTRUCTIVE FORCES ASSOCIATED WITH THESE STORMS: STORM SURGE, WIND DAMAGE, AND FLOODING.

STORM SURGE VULNERABILITY

ORMOND BEACH'S COASTAL GEOGRAPHY MAKES IT PARTICULARLY SUSCEPTIBLE TO STORM SURGE—A SUDDEN RISE IN SEA LEVEL CAUSED BY STRONG HURRICANE WINDS PUSHING WATER INLAND. HISTORICAL DATA INDICATES THAT STORM SURGES FROM HURRICANES LIKE JEANNE AND MATTHEW CAUSED COASTAL EROSION AND INUNDATION OF BARRIER ISLANDS AND BEACHFRONT PROPERTIES.

THE STORM SURGE NOT ONLY DAMAGES PROPERTY BUT ALSO THREATENS LOCAL ECOSYSTEMS, INCLUDING THE FRAGILE DUNE SYSTEMS THAT SERVE AS NATURAL BUFFERS. EFFORTS TO RESTORE AND MAINTAIN THESE DUNES HAVE BECOME CENTRAL TO MITIGATING FUTURE SURGE IMPACTS.

WIND AND STRUCTURAL DAMAGE

HURRICANE WINDS IN ORMOND BEACH HAVE VARIED FROM TROPICAL STORM FORCE TO CATEGORY 3 HURRICANE-STRENGTH GUSTS. HIGH WINDS HAVE COMPROMISED BUILDING INTEGRITY, UPROOTED TREES, AND DOWNED POWER LINES. THE 2004 AND 2017 HURRICANE SEASONS, IN PARTICULAR, HIGHLIGHTED VULNERABILITIES IN OLDER STRUCTURES AND UTILITY NETWORKS.

BUILDING CODES IN ORMOND BEACH HAVE SINCE BEEN UPDATED TO INCORPORATE MORE STRINGENT WIND RESISTANCE STANDARDS, REFLECTING LESSONS LEARNED FROM PREVIOUS STORMS. THESE CODES AIM TO ENHANCE THE DURABILITY OF NEW CONSTRUCTIONS AGAINST HURRICANE-FORCE WINDS.

FLOODING CHALLENGES

FLOODING REMAINS ONE OF THE MOST PERSISTENT AND DAMAGING EFFECTS OF HURRICANES IN ORMOND BEACH. THE CITY'S LOW-

LYING TERRAIN, COUPLED WITH HEAVY RAINFALL DURING STORMS, OFTEN RESULTS IN FLASH FLOODS AND PROLONGED WATER ACCUMULATION. THE 2004 HURRICANE JEANNE EVENT EXEMPLIFIED THE SEVERE FLOODING RISKS, WITH NEIGHBORHOODS NEAR WATERWAYS EXPERIENCING SIGNIFICANT WATER DAMAGE.

LOCAL AUTHORITIES HAVE INVESTED IN IMPROVED DRAINAGE SYSTEMS AND FLOODPLAIN MANAGEMENT TO REDUCE FLOOD RISK. HOWEVER, INCREASING RAINFALL INTENSITY LINKED TO CLIMATE CHANGE POSES ONGOING CHALLENGES FOR FLOOD CONTROL INFRASTRUCTURE.

PREPAREDNESS AND COMMUNITY RESILIENCE

THE HISTORY OF HURRICANES IN ORMOND BEACH HAS SHAPED A COMMUNITY-ORIENTED APPROACH TO DISASTER PREPAREDNESS AND RESILIENCE BUILDING. EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PRACTICES HAVE EVOLVED SIGNIFICANTLY, INTEGRATING ADVANCED METEOROLOGICAL FORECASTING, TIMELY EVACUATION PROTOCOLS, AND PUBLIC EDUCATION CAMPAIGNS.

EMERGENCY RESPONSE EVOLUTION

FOLLOWING MAJOR HURRICANES, ORMOND BEACH'S EMERGENCY RESPONSE SYSTEMS HAVE BEEN RE-EVALUATED AND ENHANCED. COORDINATION BETWEEN CITY OFFICIALS, STATE AGENCIES, AND FEDERAL ORGANIZATIONS SUCH AS FEMA ENSURES MORE EFFICIENT MOBILIZATION OF RESOURCES DURING HURRICANE THREATS.

EVACUATION ROUTES HAVE BEEN CLEARLY DEFINED, AND SHELTERS ARE BETTER EQUIPPED TO ACCOMMODATE DISPLACED RESIDENTS. THE CITY ALSO EMPLOYS REAL-TIME COMMUNICATION PLATFORMS TO DISSEMINATE WARNINGS AND UPDATES, MINIMIZING CONFUSION DURING CRITICAL PERIODS.

INFRASTRUCTURE AND ENVIRONMENTAL ADAPTATIONS

INVESTMENT IN RESILIENT INFRASTRUCTURE HAS BEEN A KEY PRIORITY FOR ORMOND BEACH, FOCUSING ON STRENGTHENING SEAWALLS, UPGRADING ELECTRICAL GRIDS, AND IMPROVING WATER MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS. ADDITIONALLY, ENVIRONMENTAL RESTORATION PROJECTS, INCLUDING THE REHABILITATION OF WETLANDS, PROVIDE NATURAL FLOOD MITIGATION BENEFITS.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT INITIATIVES ENCOURAGE RESIDENTS TO PREPARE INDIVIDUAL EMERGENCY KITS, SECURE PROPERTY, AND PARTICIPATE IN NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH PROGRAMS DURING HURRICANE SEASONS. THESE COLLECTIVE EFFORTS CONTRIBUTE TO REDUCING RISKS AND MINIMIZING RECOVERY TIMES AFTER STORMS.

COMPARATIVE PERSPECTIVES: ORMOND BEACH AND NEIGHBORING COASTAL COMMUNITIES

WHEN COMPARED TO OTHER COASTAL CITIES IN FLORIDA, ORMOND BEACH'S HURRICANE HISTORY SHARES SIMILARITIES BUT ALSO DISPLAYS UNIQUE FEATURES. FOR INSTANCE, WHILE CITIES LIKE DAYTONA BEACH AND NEW SMYRNA BEACH HAVE EXPERIENCED COMPARABLE HURRICANE FREQUENCIES, ORMOND BEACH'S SPECIFIC TOPOGRAPHY AND INFRASTRUCTURE HAVE LED TO DIFFERENT IMPACT PATTERNS.

THE CITY'S PROACTIVE STANCE IN UPDATING BUILDING CODES AND INVESTING IN NATURAL DEFENSES CONTRASTS WITH SOME NEIGHBORING AREAS WHERE DEVELOPMENT HAS SOMETIMES OUTPACED RESILIENCE MEASURES. THESE DIFFERENCES UNDERScore THE IMPORTANCE OF LOCALIZED STRATEGIES TAILORED TO COMMUNITY-SPECIFIC VULNERABILITIES.

LESSONS FROM PAST HURRICANES

ANALYZING THE HURRICANE HISTORY OF ORMOND BEACH ALONGSIDE ADJACENT AREAS REVEALS SEVERAL CRITICAL LESSONS:

- EARLY AND ACCURATE FORECASTING IS VITAL FOR EFFECTIVE EVACUATIONS AND RESOURCE ALLOCATION.
- CONTINUOUS INFRASTRUCTURE UPGRADES ARE NECESSARY TO WITHSTAND INCREASINGLY INTENSE STORMS.
- COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT AND EDUCATION ENHANCE OVERALL PREPAREDNESS AND RECOVERY CAPABILITIES.
- ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION PLAYS A CRUCIAL ROLE IN MITIGATING HURRICANE IMPACTS.

THESE INSIGHTS INFORM NOT ONLY ORMOND BEACH'S FUTURE HURRICANE READINESS BUT ALSO SERVE AS A MODEL FOR OTHER COASTAL COMMUNITIES FACING SIMILAR THREATS.

THE FUTURE OUTLOOK: CLIMATE CHANGE AND HURRICANE TRENDS

EMERGING RESEARCH ON CLIMATE CHANGE SUGGESTS THAT HURRICANES MAY BECOME MORE FREQUENT AND INTENSE DUE TO RISING SEA SURFACE TEMPERATURES AND SHIFTING ATMOSPHERIC DYNAMICS. FOR ORMOND BEACH, THIS PROJECTION EMPHASIZES THE NEED FOR ADAPTIVE PLANNING AND SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT.

LOCAL AUTHORITIES ARE INCORPORATING CLIMATE RESILIENCE INTO THEIR LONG-TERM STRATEGIES, FOCUSING ON:

- ENHANCING NATURAL BARRIERS SUCH AS DUNES AND WETLANDS
- IMPLEMENTING STRICTER ZONING LAWS TO PREVENT CONSTRUCTION IN HIGH-RISK FLOOD ZONES
- UPGRADING INFRASTRUCTURE TO COPE WITH EXTREME WEATHER EVENTS
- PROMOTING COMMUNITY-WIDE AWARENESS AND PREPAREDNESS PROGRAMS

BY ANTICIPATING FUTURE CHALLENGES, ORMOND BEACH AIMS TO MAINTAIN ITS STATUS AS A SAFE AND VIBRANT COASTAL COMMUNITY DESPITE THE INCREASING UNCERTAINTIES POSED BY HURRICANE ACTIVITY.

THE ORMOND BEACH HURRICANE HISTORY REFLECTS A NARRATIVE OF VULNERABILITY, ADAPTATION, AND RESILIENCE.
