LITERARY TECHNIQUES AND SYMBOLISM IN THURBER'S STORY

THURBER EMPLOYS A RANGE OF LITERARY DEVICES TO ENRICH THE NARRATIVE AND DEEPEN THEMATIC RESONANCE.

- **Juxtaposition:** THE ALTERNATION BETWEEN MUNDANE REALITY AND THRILLING FANTASY UNDERSCORES THE CONTRAST BETWEEN APPEARANCE AND DESIRE.
- **Irony:** WALTER MITTY'S FANTASIES OFTEN HIGHLIGHT HIS INADEQUACIES IN REAL LIFE, CREATING A BITTERSWEET TONE.
- **Symbolism:** OBJECTS SUCH AS MITTY'S DRIVING ERRANDS OR HIS WIFE'S COMMANDS SYMBOLIZE THE CONSTRAINTS OF DAILY LIFE.
