WHILE *Wonder* PRIMARILY CENTERS ON A SINGLE PROTAGONIST'S JOURNEY, HOWE'S NARRATIVE EMPHASIZES GROUP SOLIDARITY AND THE POWER OF FRIENDSHIP ACROSS DIVERSE BACKGROUNDS.

ADDITIONALLY, THE MISFITS' STRAIGHTFORWARD, DIARY-LIKE NARRATIVE STYLE CONTRASTS WITH THE MORE MULTI-PERSPECTIVE OR GRAPHIC NOVEL FORMATS FOUND IN COMPARABLE WORKS. THIS STYLE MAKES IT PARTICULARLY ACCESSIBLE TO READERS WHO PREFER TRADITIONAL STORYTELLING WHILE STILL ENGAGING WITH CONTEMPORARY SOCIAL ISSUES.

STRENGTHS AND LIMITATIONS OF THE MISFITS BY JAMES HOWE
