ANIMAL FARM AS A POLITICAL SATIRE: UNPACKING ORWELL'S MASTERPIECE

THE ROLE OF SATIRE IN POLITICAL CRITICISM

SATIRE IS A LITERARY DEVICE THAT USES HUMOR, IRONY, EXAGGERATION, OR RIDICULE TO CRITICIZE AND EXPOSE THE FLAWS OF INDIVIDUALS, INSTITUTIONS, OR SYSTEMS. IN THE CONTEXT OF *ANIMAL FARM* AS A POLITICAL SATIRE, ORWELL EMPLOYS IT TO HIGHLIGHT THE HYPOCRISY AND BETRAYAL OF REVOLUTIONARY IDEALS.

- **SNOWBALL** STANDS FOR LEON TROTSKY, STALIN'S RIVAL WHO IS ULTIMATELY EXILED.
- **THE DOGS** REPRESENT THE SECRET POLICE, ENFORCING NAPOLEON'S COMMANDS THROUGH FEAR.

- **BOXER**, THE HARDWORKING HORSE, EMBODIES THE PROLETARIAT—LOYAL BUT EXPLOITED.

THESE SYMBOLIC FIGURES ALLOW ORWELL TO DISSECT COMPLEX POLITICAL DYNAMICS THROUGH A SIMPLIFIED, YET EVOCATIVE, NARRATIVE STRUCTURE. THE TRANSFORMATION OF THE SEVEN COMMANDMENTS INTO A SINGLE PHRASE—"ALL ANIMALS ARE EQUAL, BUT SOME ANIMALS ARE MORE EQUAL THAN OTHERS"—CAPTURES THE ESSENCE OF POLITICAL HYPOCRISY AND SOCIAL STRATIFICATION.

FOR INSTANCE, JONATHAN SWIFT'S "A MODEST PROPOSAL" USES IRONY AND SHOCK TO CRITIQUE SOCIAL POLICIES, WHILE ORWELL'S APPROACH IS MORE ALLEGORICAL AND CHARACTER-DRIVEN. SIMILARLY, WORKS LIKE "1984," ALSO BY ORWELL, OFFER DYSTOPIAN VISIONS OF CONTROL, BUT ANIMAL FARM USES HUMOR AND FARMYARD SIMPLICITY TO MAKE ITS POINTS MORE ACCESSIBLE.

THIS BLEND OF ACCESSIBILITY AND DEPTH CONTRIBUTES TO ANIMAL FARM'S STATUS AS A SEMINAL POLITICAL SATIRE, BROADENING ITS APPEAL AND EFFECTIVENESS.
