### SYSTEMATIC PROBLEM-SOLVING

## CORE PRINCIPLES OF SOCIAL CASEWORK ACCORDING TO HELEN HARRIS PERLMAN

## 3. CONTROLLED EMOTIONAL INVOLVEMENT

WHILE EMPATHY IS VITAL, PERLMAN EMPHASIZED PROFESSIONAL BOUNDARIES. SOCIAL WORKERS MUST BALANCE COMPASSIONATE ENGAGEMENT WITH OBJECTIVE JUDGMENT TO AVOID BURNOUT AND MAINTAIN EFFECTIVENESS.

## 4. ACCEPTANCE

UNCONDITIONAL POSITIVE REGARD IS CRUCIAL. ACCEPTANCE FOSTERS TRUST AND RESPECT, ALLOWING CLIENTS TO EXPLORE DIFFICULT ISSUES WITHOUT FEAR OF JUDGMENT.

## 5. NONJUDGMENTAL ATTITUDE

AVOIDING MORALISTIC OR EVALUATIVE STANCES HELPS MAINTAIN CLIENT DIGNITY AND OPENNESS THROUGHOUT THE CASEWORK PROCESS.

## 6. CONFIDENTIALITY

MAINTAINING PRIVACY IS ESSENTIAL FOR ETHICAL PRACTICE AND CLIENT TRUST, EXCEPT IN SITUATIONS WHERE DISCLOSURE IS LEGALLY OR ETHICALLY MANDATED.

THESE PRINCIPLES COLLECTIVELY CREATE A FOUNDATION FOR A RESPECTFUL, EMPATHETIC, AND EFFECTIVE HELPING RELATIONSHIP.

## METHODOLOGICAL FRAMEWORK: THE PROBLEM-SOLVING PROCESS

THIS STRUCTURED APPROACH ENSURES THAT SOCIAL CASEWORK IS BOTH CLIENT-CENTERED AND GOAL-ORIENTED, FOSTERING ACCOUNTABILITY AND MEASURABLE OUTCOMES.

## COMPARATIVE PERSPECTIVES: PERLMAN'S SOCIAL CASEWORK AND OTHER MODELS
